2. A couple things that church membership is <u>NOT</u> at HCC:

- Not a ticket to <u>heaven</u>! (John 14:6)
- Not <u>acceptance</u> into the family of God.

3. A few things that church membership <u>IS</u> at HCC:

- Membership shows you gather with a **local** group of believers.
 - 1 Corinthians 1:2 "I am writing to God's **church in Corinth**..."
 - Galatians 1:2 "All the brothers and sisters here join me in sending this letter to the **churches in Galatia**."
 - 1 Thessalonians 1:1 "We are writing to the **church in Thessalonica**..."
 - Acts 2:41 "Those who believed what Peter said were baptized and added to the church (in Jerusalem) that day."
- Membership shows a **<u>commitment</u>** to a specific church family.
 - We are committed to each other.
 - We are committed to **serving** one another by using our spiritual gifts to benefit others in this church family.
 - Romans 12:4-13
 - Ephesians 4:15-16
- Membership shows a <u>like-mindedness</u> and unity in beliefs with the other members of the church.
- Membership shows our willingness to submit to the organizational structure of the church.
 - God-designed leadership structure within the church.

- Acts 6, 1 Timothy 3, & Titus 1
- God-designed discipline measures within the church.
 Matthew 18:15-17, 1 Corinthians 5, & Galatians 6:1
- Members get to vote.

4. Membership in God's family is the most important membership. Are you certain you're a member of His family?

- If you were to die today in a car accident, do you know beyond a shadow of a doubt where you'd go?
- If you were to die today and you were standing at the gates of heaven and God asked, "Why should I let you into my heaven?" What would you say?
- If someone asks you, "What must I do to be saved?" What would you tell them?
- Ephesians 2:1-10
 - You were **<u>dead</u>** (separated from God) Ephesians 2:1-3
 - God **raised** us from the dead along with Christ Ephesians 2:4-7
 - God saved you by his grace when you **<u>believed</u>** Ephesians 2:8-10
- Galatians 2:21 "I do not treat the grace of God as meaningless. For if keeping the law could make us right with God, then there was no need for Christ to die."
