#### 1. Review

- Paul is still on his 3rd missionary journey continuing to be a witness for Jesus in Asia (Modern day western Turkey).
- Last week, we read that God gave Paul the ability to do unusual miracles in the magic and sorcery filled city of Ephesus.
- 7 Jewish brothers tried expelling an evil spirit from a man but the evil spirit attacked them and they fled naked and battered.

## 2. Text

### Acts 19:21-22

• Paul felt **compelled** by the Spirit to go back to Macedonia (Philippi, Thessalonica, Berea) and Achaia (Athens, Corinth), and Jerusalem, and then on to Rome.

## Acts 19:23-34

- A <u>riot</u> started in Ephesus by a man named Demetrius.
- Demetrius was a a silversmith in Ephesus whose income & <u>wealth</u> depended on the worship of the goddess Artemis and on tourism to her temple.
  - He manufactured silver shrines of Artemis, and his large business was <u>losing</u> income due to Paul's teaching and influence.
  - Artemis (known as "Diana" to the Romans) was 1 of the 12 gods and goddesses of the "Greek Pantheon". She was the goddess of the hunt, fertility, virginity, and safe childbearing.
  - The **temple** of Artemis was one of the 7 wonders of the world and was a tourist destination for people all throughout the Roman world.
- Demetrius claimed concern that people would no longer revere the handmade gods, the temple of Artemis would lose influence, and that the magnificent goddess Artemis would be robbed of her great prestige throughout Asia.
  - You could say Demetrius worshipped 2 gods... wealth and Artemis, and both were under attack, so he felt he had to do something.

#### Acts 19:35-41

 Summary: The mayor calmed and dispersed the riotous crowd by affirming Artemis' unquestioned greatness, declaring the innocence of Gaius & Aristarchus, and then warning everyone about what might happen if the Roman government hears about them rioting.

# 3. Perspectives:

- God uses unknowns and no names like Erastus, Aristarchus, Gaius... and us!
  - **Ephesians 2:10** "For we are God's masterpiece (handiwork-NIV). He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago.
  - Colossians 3:23-24 "Work willingly at whatever you do, as though you were working for the Lord rather than for people. Remember that the Lord will give you an inheritance as your reward, and that the Master you are serving is Christ."
- Faith in the one true God will result in an eternity with Him. Faith in a little "g" god is temporal and will end in... ruins.
  - People in Ephesus were thoroughly convinced what they were believing in was true, but it actually wasn't. The same thing is still happening today.
