Here Comes Your King

- (Everyday) Before you begin your study time - spend time in prayer, preparing your heart and surrendering your will to the Spirit of God! Allow Him to have full access by not withholding anything He wants to do in and then do through you!!
- (Everyday) Remember, the enemy is going to try to keep you from being in the Word, he hates when we worship our God- Worship breaks his bondages over believers, so resist him and he will flee!!
- (Everyday) Spend time in adoration and worship daily after you have cleansed your heart and before you dive into the scriptures!! Proclaiming who God is and adoring Him lifts our eyes up and keeps our focus on what really matters...putting God in His rightful place and putting us in ours!
- BONUS- (If you have not done this already) if you were at the “Digging Deeper” conference and you would like to structure these scriptures, Copy and paste Revelation 19 into a word/pages document or write it out verse by verse, following the structuring handouts you received! If you were not and want to watch it, search “Digging Deeper” on our website and watch the mini conference. If you the handout, please email me and I will send it to you.
- Review all of chapter 19:1-10 and what you have learned about the supper that the Lord has prepared for His bride! Then read quickly through all chapter 19 to get an overview and reminder of what it contains.

- Review your timeline of the events of Revelation! Where are we at right in these verses on our timeline?
- Look at verse 10, what is John referring to at the very end of verse 10? How does this launch us into this next section? (Read in NLT to get a better understanding of it because the wording is difficult)
- There is a transition from the first part of chapter 19, and the second! What is that transition and where is John's focus in each?
- Look at verse 11, what does John see here?
- Who is this? Compare and contrast this description to Revelation 6:1-2! We discussed this in class! How has the first horsemen tried to mimic and counterfeit copy Jesus Christ?
- Knowing that this is his goal, how should you and I be so very careful throughout our lives to make sure we do not get duped by the enemy? How can we make sure we are not deceived? See what scriptures you can find that warn believers of the deceptions of the enemy..record them, and the instructions of how to practically protect ourselves!
- Notice we have 2 names of Christ in this verse, write them down and look up their meanings! What does this tell you about who Christ is? Make sure to record in your "Who is God" journal what you discover!!
- Read Revelation 3:14 and compare His description to this verse!
- Look back at Rev. 19:11, what does He do? (Record in your journal)
- Because of who He is and what He does, how does that define who you are?
- Then how does that determine what you do?
- What an awesome God we serve!! We can be safe in Him- we can trust Him in all we do and say!! He is a good good God!! What is going on in

your life right now where you are struggling with protection? Security? Provision? And identity? How does this TRUTH change your perspective? How does this challenge what you truly believe about God? Do you struggle to let the truth and facts from the Word of God guide you instead of your feelings? If so, why do you think that is? What needs to change?

- Look at the chart you were given in class (or below) and look at the first and second coming of Christ! Record your thoughts on this...what does seeing the beauty of what Jesus did and is going to do, do to your faith?

The First Coming Of Christ	The Second Comings of Jesus Christ
He rode a donkey.	He will ride a white horse.
He came as the Suffering Servant.	He will come as Conquering King and Lord.
He came in humility and meekness.	He will come in majesty and power.
He came to suffer the wrath of God for sinners.	He will come to establish the kingdom of God for His saints.
He was rejected by many as the Messiah.	He will be recognized by ALL as Lord.
He came to seek and save the lost	He will come to judge and rule as King.
He came as God in flesh	He will come as God in all His splendor.

- Don't forget to look up any words in verse 11 that you want further insight on! If you have not done so already, download blue letter bible app and click the verse, then click interlinear concordance and select the word you want more insight on! Let me know if you have any questions at all!
- The second coming of Christ is the event in which men from 2000 years ago have looked forward to! It has crossed barriers of cultures and continents, and it has been the motivating catalyst for every minister of the gospel and Jesus Christ- This is BIG DEAL! Read the statistics below that we discussed in class and record your thoughts on this! How important it is that we understand the fullness of God's beautiful plan as it is confirmed and fulfilled by His second coming!
 - Next to faith, the 2nd coming is the most talked about subject in the Bible!
 - The 2nd coming is talked about 1,845 times in the Bible
 - 1, 527 OT- 318 NT
 - 1 out of every 30 verses in the Bible speaks of or alludes to the 2nd coming and end of days
 - For every one time the 1st coming of Christ is mentioned- the 2nd coming is mentioned 8 times
 - For every one time atonement is mentioned - the 2nd coming is mentioned twice
 - 21 times Jesus referred to His return-
 - Over 50 times the Bible tells us to be ready for His return

- Wow!! That is incredible isn't it? He is surely coming again!!! Look up the following verses (there are a lot more 😘) and record what you learn about the second coming! (If you have time, feel free to do a search and see what other verses you can find about the 2nd coming and record!)
 - Daniel 7:13-14;

- Zechariah 14:1-11 (all of this chapter really)
 - Matthew 24:29-31, 36-44; 25:1-26
 - Mark 13:24-27
 - Luke 21:25-28; Acts 1:9-11
 - Revelation 11:15-19; 14:14-20; 16:12-21; and 19:11-21
 - Acts 1:9-12
 - Romans 8:18-25
- How do these verses grow and solidify your faith?
 - Look through the notes you just made and try to compile a list of truths you have learned about the second coming, what does this tell you? What will it be like? Can you believe you and I, with all of the saints who have put their faith in Jesus Christ, will be there?!
 - Here we will finally see the LION and the LAMB in all of His glory- we know Christ will forever be the Lamb of God who took away the sin of the world- however, the Lion will now shine forth as the King of all Kings!! Ruling and reigning forever!! WAHOO!! See what verses you can find about Jesus being the Lion of Judah, and record in light of what you are learning here about the second coming of Christ!!
 - Read verse 12 of Revelation 19 and record the description you see of Jesus in this verse! Then compare that to Revelation 1:12-19!
 - Look up any words you want more insight on! Can you imagine what it will be like to see Him face to face?! What a day that will be!!
 - We see the third name of Christ here in verse 12, what is it? Why do you think it is concealed?
 - Read verse 13, what do you see here? Whose blood is His robe dipped in? Read Revelation 14:20, Isaiah 63:1-6 and Joel 3:13-14 and record what you find!

- The 4th name of Christ is mentioned here in verse 13, what is it? Look up the words you see here! Then compare to John 1:1-2 and 1:14, and Hebrews 1:2! What do you see? What does this tell you about the necessity to know and fall in love with the Word of God! How is your love for the Word of God? Do you truly love His Word? If your answer is “no”, do not sit and condemn yourself, the only way to grow in your love for God’s Word, is to grow in your discipline to study it! The more you study it, the more you are washed by it, the more you are washed by it, the more you live it, the more you live it, you will find yourself so in love with His Word - in love with Him! Then you realized how desperately you need it - more than food or water! But it starts with discipline- consistent discipline, then turns into everyday necessity and JOY! Take it one day at a time and be diligent to make sure you are consistent and your whole heart and world will change because... well, let’s be honest...how can it not?! You’re taking in the very essence of God in Christ Jesus...it is supernatural and it is transformational! No wonder the enemy tries so hard to keep us out of it- do not let him!!
- Look at verse 14, who are these armies?
- Look at verses 6-8 and let scriptures tell us who they are!! What do you see? Try to put yourself in this scene and read the following verses and record what you find:
 - Zechariah 14:5
 - 2 Thessalonians 1:7
 - Jude 14-15
 - Revelation 17:13-14
- Believers clothed in the imputed righteousness of Christ and their righteous deeds come “on white horses, wearing pure white linen!” Can you imagine? What a glorious day that will be!! Write out a prayer to the Lord thanking Him for what He has done to allow you to be able to be there! How incredible the privilege and honor to be with Him!!

- You and I will only be merely spectators, we will come behind Him, watching Him in all of His glory and we will watch as the word of His mouth crumbles the nations that have shaken their fists at God and have rejected the grace offered to them! In an instant, they will fall and all will see the glory and majesty of the Ruler of all nations, the One and Only Savior and Messiah Jesus Christ our Lord!!
- We will not fight as some think- we will watch in amazement! However, just like we talked about in our study, if your want to fight....fight for the purity of your mind, fight to be conformed to the image of Christ, fight to stay in the Word of God, fight to crucify your flesh, fight to have healthy, godly relationships, fight to serve with love, fight to make sure the Lord is on the throne of your heart, fight to pursue righteousness, fight in prayer for the salvation of the souls around you...you want to fight, that is how you fight!! And leave the judgment and the battle to the Lord!
- So, how is your fight going? Are you fighting the right things?
- Read verse 15, look up any words you want further insight on! What do you see in this verse? Read Isaiah 11:4 and record how this verse is prophecy about this very moment in time! How long ago was Isaiah written? (Just saying 😊)
- Read Hebrews 4:12-13 slowly! Record the beauty of this verse and what you see about the “Sword”! How does this verse challenge you? How does this verse expose what the struggle or wrestling that happens in your heart when you hear the Word of God and you look into the mirror of His Word? What two choices are you left with every time the grace of God exposes sin in your life? When the Spirit of God convicts you? What do you do? What are your first thoughts?
- Look at the “rod of iron” part of this verse and compare with Psalms 2:7-9 and if you have time read the whole chapter! This is the messianic psalm and is just incredible! Then do a word study on the “rod of iron” and record what you find!

- Look up the “winepress”, and record what you see! Also, do a word search on “winepress” and really look at the fullness of what happens during the winepress! What Jesus has done for us and what that represents!! This is so incredible and leaves me so very thankful to the Lord for what He has done! Take some time and worship Him for the gift God has given through Jesus Christ!!
- Read verse 16, the 5th and 6th name of Christ is mentioned here! What do you see? Don’t forget to record in your Who is God Journal! What does this tell you about God? What He has done? Who you are? What you do?
- Read verses 17-18, what do you see here? Read Matt 24:26-30 and how does this compare and give further insight on this verse?
- What do birds sometimes represent in scripture? Notice how no one escapes, it affects both great and small! The Lord has given so many chances- over and over again...the people who are here are people who have outright rejected and denied the gift of Jesus Christ! No one will be here uninformed or by accident! This will be their choice!
- Notice how there are two suppers here in chapter 19, compare and contrast them! Write out everything you see about them, who are they for? Who is invited? Why? What happens?
- This will not be private, secret or pleasant for unbelievers! This should give us an urgency for those we know that do not know the Lord! Spend some time writing out all the names of the people you know and love that do not know the Lord and dedicate to pray for their salvation! Ask the Lord to give you open doors and opportunities to speak into their lives! Pray for soften hearts and willingness to seek the Lord with their whole heart!
- There is always two choices! Below is a chart you can keep in your binder to remind you of the two choices we/the world is always faced with! (I had some ladies ask for this so you could refer back to it!)

Two Choices of Revelation

<u>Two Religions:</u>	God	Everything else
<u>Two Women:</u>	Israel	Babylon
<u>Two Cities:</u>	Jerusalem	Babylon
<u>Two Rulers:</u>	God	Satan
<u>Two Messages:</u>	Salvation, Redemption, and Forgiveness	Blasphemy, Immorality, and Idolatry
<u>Two Endings:</u>	Finished on the cross where the wrath of God poured out on the Son of God	Finished on earth where the wrath of God will be poured out on a Christ rejecting world
<u>Two Destinations:</u>	Eternity in Heaven with God	Eternity in hell separated from God
<u>Two Suppers:</u>	Marriage Supper of the Lamb for believers	The Great Supper of God for unbelievers

- Read verse 19, who is on the scene here? Write what you have learned about them this far! What is their plan, purpose, and goal?
- What happens to them in verse 20? Look at the details of this verse, what does this tell you about the lake of fire? What does this tell you about what they have done?
- In class we discussed how we have to be so very careful not be deceived, that everything that looks like a miracle is not a miracle, and every miracle is not from God! Record your thoughts on this and then record what you need to do in order to make sure you are not deceived!
- Read verse 21, what happens to the rest of those who try to make war against the King of Kings and Lord of Lords?
- Read Titus 2:11-14, pay close attention to verse 13, what do you see? Notice the flow from grace to glory! Can you hardly wait?! What a gift we have been given - what a joy it will be!! He is King of Kings and Ruler of all!
- Read and record Phil. 2:8-11, and 2 Tim. 4:6-8 and spend the remainder of today in worship to the Lord! Praising Him for making a way! Praising Him for what He has done!! We serve an AWESOME GOD AND HE IS COMING SOON!! Are you ready? Do you long for His appearing?
- Below is the poem that I read at the end of class! What a blessing this is!! May it bring you to your knees in awe and worship of the One we serve and follow!!!

“The Incomparable Christ”

“More than nineteen hundred years ago (now 2000 years- added by me) there was a Man born contrary to the laws of life. This Man lived in poverty and was reared in obscurity.
