
A FUTURE AND A LOOP'S FAITHFULNESS IN SUFFERING

SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS



Week 1

Text: Jeremiah 29:11

Topic(s): God's Sovereignty, Future, Hope, Trust

Big Idea of the Message: We take this verse out of context when we believe that God will allow only good things to happen to us. Looking at it in context reveals that it is a promise of delayed relief to those deep in suffering, not a promise that we will never encounter suffering.

Application Point: When we read promises out of context, we believe God has failed us when life proves as challenging as it often is. When we read *in* context, we realize that God's faithfulness transcends our suffering, that we can persevere through suffering by the strength of his presence.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. What is one thing that stood out to you from this week's message?
- 2. Where have you seen Jeremiah 29:11 misunderstood or taken out of context?
- 3. How does your understanding of God's promise change when you consider the context of the people he spoke it to?
- 4. Reflect on a time when you suffered far worse and far longer than you expected. How did this affect your understanding of God? Does this sermon and reflection change that understanding?
- 5. How can we teach the next generation to put their trust in God's presence, faithfulness, and redemption while acknowledging the reality of God's timeline and the suffering in the world?
- 6. How can we pray for you?
