#### LIVING THE LIFE OF PROPER RESPONSE Sermon Series: "Living The Psalms Together" (A year-long study through The Psalms) Psalm 118 April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2023 Pastor Frank Mack Family Life Christian Church

Now when they drew near to Jerusalem, to Bethphage and Bethany, at the Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two of his disciples <sup>2</sup> and said to them, "Go into the village in front of you, and immediately as you enter it you will find a colt tied, on which no one has ever sat. Untie it and bring it. <sup>3</sup> If anyone says to you, 'Why are you doing this?' say, 'The Lord has need of it and will send it back here immediately.' "<sup>4</sup> And they went away and found a colt tied at a door outside in the street, and they untied it. <sup>5</sup> And some of those standing there said to them, "What are you doing, untying the colt?" <sup>6</sup> And they told them what Jesus had said, and they let them go. <sup>7</sup> And they brought the colt to Jesus and threw their cloaks on it, and he sat on it. <sup>8</sup> And many spread their cloaks on the road, and others spread leafy branches that they had cut from the fields. <sup>9</sup> And those who went before and those who followed were shouting, "Hosanna! <u>Blessed is He</u> <u>who comes in the name of the Lord!</u> <sup>10</sup> Blessed is the coming kingdom of our father David! Hosanna in the highest!" Mark 11:1-10 (ESV)

## 4 Practical Responses to Everyday Life

# 1. IN EVERY SITUATION THANK THE LORD (vss. 1-4)

"Oh give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; for his steadfast love endures forever! <sup>2</sup> Let Israel say, "His steadfast love endures forever." <sup>3</sup>Let the house of Aaron say, "His steadfast love endures forever." <sup>4</sup> Let those who fear the LORD say, "His steadfast love endures forever." **Psalm 118:1-4 (ESV)** 

"I am speaking the truth in Christ—I am not lying; my conscience bears me witness in the Holy Spirit—<sup>2</sup> that I have great sorrow and unceasing anguish in my heart. <sup>3</sup> For I could wish that I myself were accursed and cut off from Christ for the sake of my brothers, my kinsmen according to the flesh. <sup>4</sup> They are Israelites, and to them belong the adoption, the glory, the covenants, the giving of the law, the worship, and the promises. <sup>5</sup> To them belong the patriarchs, and from their race, according to the flesh, is the Christ, who is God over all, blessed forever. Amen." **Romans 9:1-5 (ESV)** 

"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places..." **Ephesians 1:3 (ESV)** 

# 2. IN EVERY CRISIS TRUST THE LORD (vss. 5-14)

"Keep your life free from love of money, and be content with what you have, for he has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." <sup>6</sup> So we can confidently say, "The Lord is my helper; I will not fear; what can man do to me?" **Hebrews 13:5-6 (ESV)**  <sup>5</sup> Out of my distress I called on the LORD; the LORD answered me and set me free. <sup>6</sup> The LORD is on my side; I will not fear. What can man do to me? <sup>7</sup> The LORD is on my side as my helper; I shall look in triumph on those who hate me. <sup>8</sup> It is better to take refuge in the LORD than to trust in man. <sup>9</sup> It is better to take refuge in the LORD than to trust in princes. <sup>10</sup> All nations surrounded me; in the name of the LORD I cut them off! <sup>11</sup> They surrounded me, surrounded me on every side; in the name of the LORD I cut them off! <sup>12</sup> They surrounded me like bees; they went out like a fire among thorns; in the name of the LORD helped me. <sup>14</sup> The LORD is my strength and my song; he has become my salvation." Psalm 118:5-14 (ESV)

## 3. AFTER EVERY VICTORY GLORIFY THE LORD (vss. 15-21)

<sup>15</sup> Glad songs of salvation are in the tents of the righteous: "The right hand of the LORD does valiantly, <sup>16</sup> the right hand of the LORD exalts, the right hand of the LORD does valiantly!" <sup>17</sup> I shall not die, but I shall live, and recount the deeds of the LORD. <sup>18</sup> The LORD has disciplined me severely, but he has not given me over to death. <sup>19</sup> Open to me the gates of righteousness, that I may enter through them and give thanks to the LORD. <sup>20</sup> This is the gate of the LORD; the righteous shall enter through it. <sup>21</sup> I thank you that you have answered me and have become my salvation." **Psalm 118:15-21 (ESV)** 

"And all Israel in the days of Zerubbabel and in the days of Nehemiah gave the daily portions for the singers and the gatekeepers; and they set apart that which was for the Levites; and the Levites set apart that which was for the sons of Aaron." **Nehemiah 12:47** (ESV)

#### 4. IN EVERY EXPERIENCE SEE THE LORD (vss. 22-29)

<sup>22</sup> The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone. <sup>23</sup> This is the LORD's doing; it is marvelous in our eyes. <sup>24</sup> This is the day that the LORD has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it. <sup>25</sup> Save us, we pray, O LORD! O LORD, we pray, give us success! <sup>26</sup> Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD! We bless you from the house of the LORD. <sup>27</sup> The LORD is God, and he has made his light to shine upon us. Bind the festal sacrifice with cords, up to the horns of the altar! <sup>28</sup> You are my God, and I will give thanks to you; you are my God; I will extol you. <sup>29</sup> Oh give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; for his steadfast love endures forever!" Psalm 118:25-29 (ESV)

<sup>42</sup> Jesus said to them, "Have you never read in the Scriptures: " 'The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone; this was the Lord's doing, and it is marvelous in our eyes'? <sup>43</sup> Therefore I tell you, the kingdom of God will be taken away from you and given to a people producing its fruits. <sup>44</sup> And the one who falls on this stone will be broken to pieces; and when it falls on anyone, it will crush him." **Matthew 21:42- 44 (ESV)** 

<sup>6</sup> For it stands in Scripture: "Behold, I am laying in Zion a stone, a cornerstone chosen and precious, and whoever believes in him will not be put to shame." <sup>7</sup> So the honor is for you who believe, but for those who do not believe, "The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone," <sup>8</sup> and "A stone of stumbling, and a rock of offense." **1 Peter 2:6-8 (ESV)** 

Over 2000 years ago Jesus rode into Jerusalem on the back of a donkey proclaiming the coming of Kingdom of God. People shouted, *"Hosanna, Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord."* Jesus is now in His Kingdom and on His throne as King; will you today surrender your life to His Lordship and make Him the King of your life?
