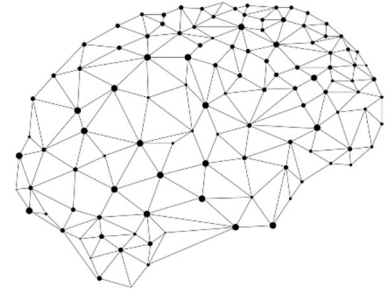

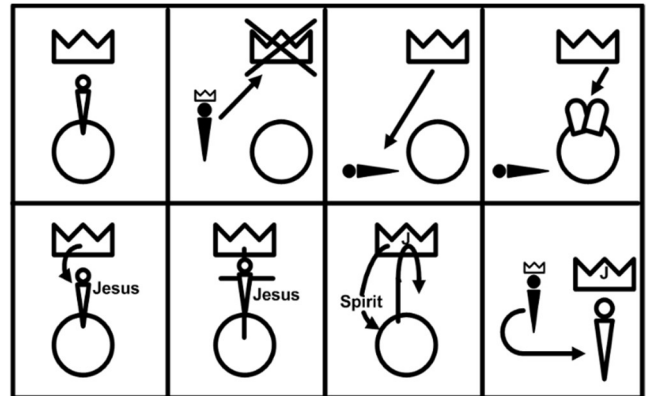
## MAKING GOD KNOWN BY BEING PREPARED . . .

TO GIVE A \_\_\_\_\_ (see 22:1)

- To testify to the facts about Jesus (23:11)
- What are “the \_\_\_\_\_?”
  - The Data Points (in this passage)
    - Jesus is the Righteous One (22:14)
    - That we must call on His name, be baptized and wash away our sins (22:16)
    - That this is the Good News for ALL People (22:21)
    - The hope and resurrection of the dead (23:6)
  - The 8 Simple Drawings
  - The Statement of Faith “Die-Fors”

TO SHARE YOUR \_\_\_\_\_ (see 22:3ff)

- “Before I met Jesus I was . . .” (22:3-5)
- “How I met Jesus was . . .” (22:6-16)
- “Now that I met Jesus I am . . .”(22:17-21)



TO FACE A \_\_\_\_\_ (see 22:22ff)

- Accusation: Speaking against “against the people and the law and this place” (21:28)
  - Often not understood by the “unchurched” (22:30)
- Accusation: From “ \_\_\_\_\_” (Sadducces)
- Accusation: From “ \_\_\_\_\_” (Pharisees)
- Responding by looking for points of connection
  - Paul’s heritage (22:3-5, 19-20)
  - Paul’s agreement with the Pharisees about the resurrection (23:6)
- Responding by pointing out inconsistency, yet with gentleness and \_\_\_\_\_ (23:1-5)
- Responding with \_\_\_\_\_ in God’s sovereignty, promises, and grace (23:11, cf. 23:12ff)
