

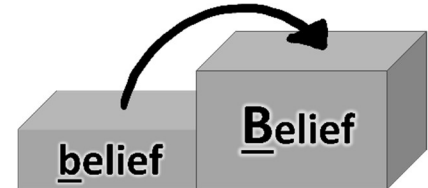
JOHN 11 - Capitalizing our **B**elief
