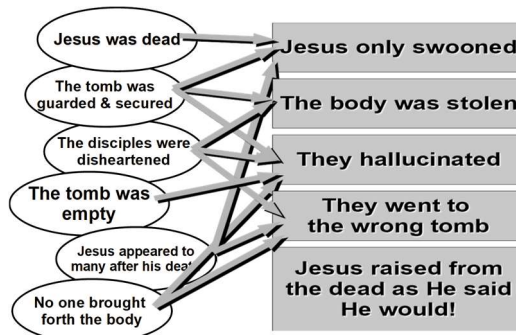
Jesus —Israel's promised Messiah— was conceived through the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary.
