The Killer Lie: "CASUAL Pleasure Doesn't REALLY Hurt Anyone..."

- "But Everyone Does It..."
- "But We Didn't Cross the Line..."
- "But I Only Looked at the Menu. I Didn't Order Anything."
- "But We're Committed to Each Other, and It's Consensual."

The Biblical Truth: God's GOOD Design is COVENANTAL Purity
It's about Seeking, First and Foremost, to God (1 Th. 4:1) - Purity begins, continues, and ends with our Ultimate Relationship with God through Christ (1 Cor. 6:13-15; 7:6-9, 32-35; Mt. 22:29-30)
It's about God's for your life, Growing in Christlikeness (sanctification) (1 Th. 4:2-6) from Sexual Immorality ("porneia" of mind, heart, or body) o Choosing Holy Spirit Self-Control o Knowing that first, it's against God, and second, it's our brother or sister in the Lord
It's about God's on your life, to be Holy (set apart) Devoted to Him (1 Th. 4:7-8) - And remembering this is about the Church's Religious Rules for you
