PAUL WARNED THE EPHESIAN $\qquad$ (Acts 20:28-31)

## Gives an example of a true teacher:

Shares all profitable, in all settings, with all audiences, the whole message of repentance and faith,
$\square$ Seeks the reward of finishing the course, not seeking $\qquad$ .

## Warns of false teachers:

 to yourselves and to all the flock - we have been warned,"Wolves" will appear after strong leaders leave,
May come from $\qquad$ ,
$\square$ Will twist the truth,

PAUL WARNED TIMOTHY (2 Timothy 3:6-17)
Warns of false teachers:
