WARNED HIS DISCIPLES (Matt 24:4-5; Mark 13:21-23) " – we have been warned.

The christs and prophets will be so convincing that they could almost lead astray the elect.



PAUL WARNED THE EPHESIAN (Acts 20:28-31)

Gives an example of a true teacher:

- Shares all profitable, in all settings, with all audiences, the whole message of repentance and \square faith.
- Seeks the reward of finishing the course, not seeking

Warns of false teachers:

- to yourselves and to all the flock we have been warned,
- "Wolves" will appear after strong leaders leave,
- May come from
- □ Will twist the truth,
- □ Will make disciples of .



PAUL WARNED TIMOTHY (2 Timothy 3:6-17)

Warns of false teachers:

- □ They will prey on people's burdens, passions, and the love of ","
- They will oppose the truth and solid teachers but will eventually be revealed for who they really are,
- □ They will go from , deceiving and being deceived.

Gives an example of a true teacher:

- _ can observe their teaching, conduct, aim in life, faith, patience,
