 - a. The Eternal Covenant
 - i. Jer. 33:17-22
 - b. Fall of Jerusalem, The promise is crushed
 - i. Jer. 34:1-3, promised by God
 - ii. Jer. 38:2-4, they assumed God's plan
 - iii. Jer. 39:1-8, Jerusalem falls
 - c. They still plotted their own course in fear/wisdom
 - i. Jer. 42, they fled to Egypt in fear of Babylon crushing them again
 - d. Hope Promised through a shoot
 - i. Jer. 33:14-16
2. New Covenant Day
 - . Hebrews 11:13-16, the transition is made
 - a. Hebrews 12:1-2, lay aside the assumptions of hope
 - b. 1 John 2:15-17, we cannot grab and hold at the present order
