John 11:46-48

## Questions Worth Asking

There is no riding the fence when it comes to Jesus. Either he is God the Son or he is a lunatic. He can't simply be a prophet or a good guy. The council realized this as they saw how Jesus was tearing the fabric of their world apart. To ignore Jesus would lead to their position, power, prestige and posterity being compromised. A decision had to be made on what to do with this guy claiming to be one with the Father. There were two camps to choose from: 1. commit to Christ or 2. kill the King. Many believed that Jesus was worthy of their life, but the Jewish leaders valued their status above the Savior. Rather than believe in the one who gave them life, they made plans to take his life. In moments of crisis or comfort, some believers have a tendency to act as if Christ isn't worth their time. We must daily decide to commit to a Lord that is worthy of our entire life.

## Steps Worth Taking

Here are some **suggested steps** that will help you give Christ what he's worthy of...

1. Identify a few things in your life that have garnered a great deal of your attention and time (i.e. a new show, book, etc.).
2. Determine to let something from that list go and take that time to read the Bible, pray and/or journal.
3. Share with someone what happened when you decided to make the Lord your priority because you believe he is worthy of your life.
