THE LORD'S PREPARATION OF MOSES AND AARON

EXODUS 6:14-7:7

1. THEIR GENEALOGY

Exodus 6:14-27 (NASB) 14 These are the heads of their fathers' households. The sons of Reuben, Israel's firstborn: Hanoch and Pallu, Hezron and Carmi; these are the families of Reuben. **15** The sons of Simeon: Jemuel and Jamin and Ohad and Jachin and Zohar and Shaul the son of a Canaanite woman; these are the families of Simeon.

16 These are the names of the sons of Levi according to their generations: Gershon and Kohath and Merari; and the length of Levi's life was one hundred and thirty-seven years. **17** The sons of Gershon: Libni and Shimei, according to their families. **18** The sons of Kohath: Amram and Izhar and Hebron and Uzziel; and the length of Kohath's life was one hundred and thirty-three years. **19** The sons of Merari: Mahli and Mushi. These are the families of the Levites according to their generations. **20** Amram married his father's sister Jochebed, and she bore him Aaron and Moses; and the length of Amram's life was one hundred and thirty-seven years. **21** The sons of Izhar: Korah and Nepheg and Zichri. **22** The sons of Uzziel: Mishael and Elzaphan and Sithri. **23** Aaron married Elisheba, the daughter of Amminadab, the sister of Nahshon, and she bore him Nadab and Abihu, Eleazar and Ithamar. **24** The sons of Korah: Assir and Elkanah and Abiasaph; these are the families of the Korahites. **25** Aaron's son Eleazar married one of the daughters of Putiel, and she bore him Phinehas. These are the heads of the fathers' households of the Levites according to their families. **26** It was the same Aaron and Moses to whom the Lord said, "Bring out the sons of Israel from the land of Egypt according to their hosts." **27** They were the ones who spoke to Pharaoh king of Egypt about bringing out the sons of Israel from Egypt; it was the same Moses and Aaron.

2. THEIR CALL AND COMMISSION

Exodus 6:28-7:7 (NASB) **28** Now it came about on the day when the Lord spoke to Moses in the land of Egypt, **29** that the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, "I am the Lord; speak to Pharaoh king of Egypt all that I speak to you." **30** But Moses said before the Lord, "Behold, I am unskilled in speech; how then will Pharaoh listen to me?"

1 Then the Lord said to Moses, "See, I make you as God to Pharaoh, and your brother Aaron shall be your prophet. **2** You shall speak all

that I command you, and your brother Aaron shall speak to Pharaoh that he let the sons of Israel go out of his land. **3** But I will harden Pharaoh's heart that I may multiply My signs and My wonders in the land of Egypt. **4** When Pharaoh does not listen to you, then I will lay My hand on Egypt and bring out My hosts, My people the sons of Israel, from the land of Egypt by great judgments. **5** The Egyptians shall know that I am the Lord, when I stretch out My hand on Egypt and bring out the sons of Israel from their midst." **6** So Moses and Aaron did it; as the Lord commanded them, thus they did. **7** Moses was eighty years old and Aaron eighty-three, when they spoke to Pharaoh.
