Luke 23:50-56 (NASB) **50** And a man named Joseph, who was a member of the Council, a good and righteous man **51** (he had not consented to their plan and action), a man from Arimathea, a city of the Jews, who was waiting for the kingdom of God; **52** this man went to Pilate and asked for the body of Jesus. **53** And he took it down and wrapped it in a linen cloth, and laid Him in a tomb cut into the rock, where no one had ever lain. **54** It was the preparation day, and the Sabbath was about to begin. **55** Now the women who had come with Him out of Galilee followed, and saw the tomb and how His body was laid. **56** Then they returned and prepared spices and perfumes.
