LUKE 23:1-12

Luke 23:1-7 (NASB) **1** Then the whole body of them got up and brought Him before Pilate. **2** And they began to accuse Him, saying, "We found this man misleading our nation and forbidding to pay taxes to Caesar, and saying that He Himself is Christ, a King." **3** So Pilate asked Him, saying, "Are You the King of the Jews?" And He answered him and said, "It is as you say." **4** Then Pilate said to the chief priests and the crowds, "I find no guilt in this man." **5** But they kept on insisting, saying, "He stirs up the people, teaching all over Judea, starting from Galilee even as far as this place." **6** When Pilate heard it, he asked whether the man was a Galilean. **7** And when he learned that He belonged to Herod's jurisdiction, he sent Him to Herod, who himself also was in Jerusalem at that time.

Luke 23:8-12 (NASB) **8** Now Herod was very glad when he saw Jesus; for he had wanted to see Him for a long time, because he had been hearing about Him and was hoping to see some sign performed by Him. **9** And he questioned Him at some length; but He answered him nothing. **10** And the chief priests and the scribes were standing there, accusing Him vehemently. **11** And Herod with his soldiers, after treating Him with contempt and mocking Him, dressed Him in a gorgeous robe and sent Him back to Pilate. **12** Now Herod and Pilate became friends with one another that very day; for before they had been enemies with each other.

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
