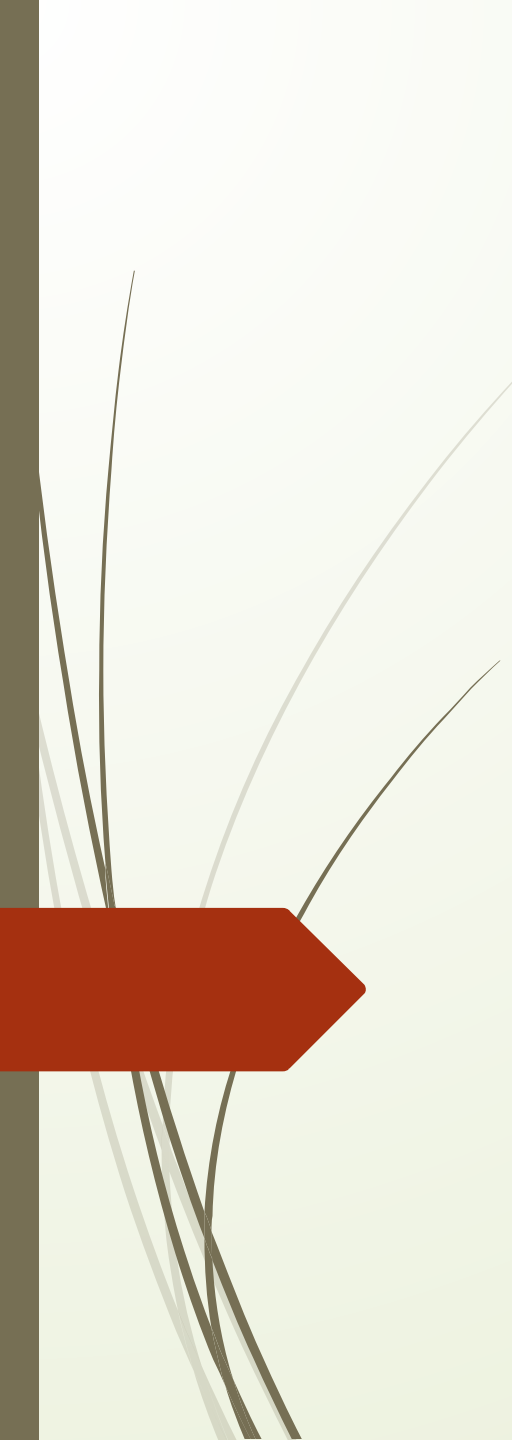




Evangelists, Shepherds & Teachers

of God,





□ to mature manhood, to
the measure of the stature
of the fullness of Christ,



□¹⁴ so that we may no
longer be children, tossed
to and fro by the waves
and carried about by



□ every wind of
doctrine, by human
cunning, by craftiness
in deceitful schemes.



□¹⁵ Rather, speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in every way into him who is the



□ head, into Christ,
1⁶from whom the whole
body, joined and held
together by every joint

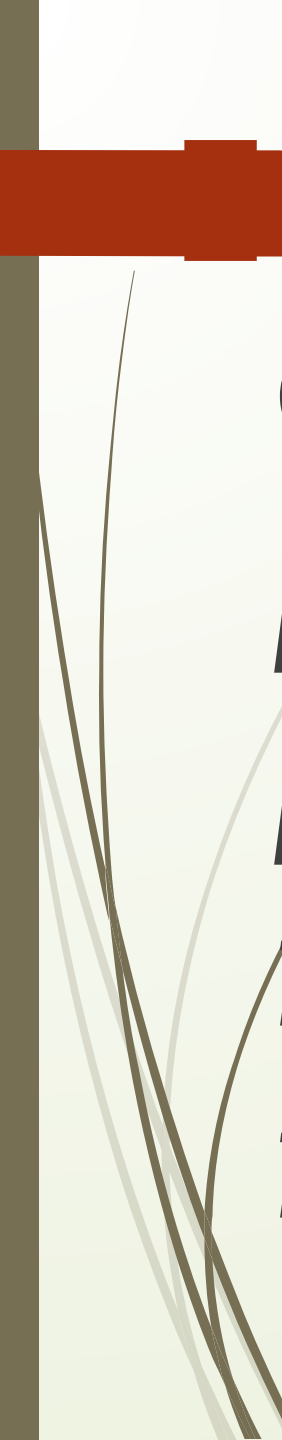


□ with which it is
