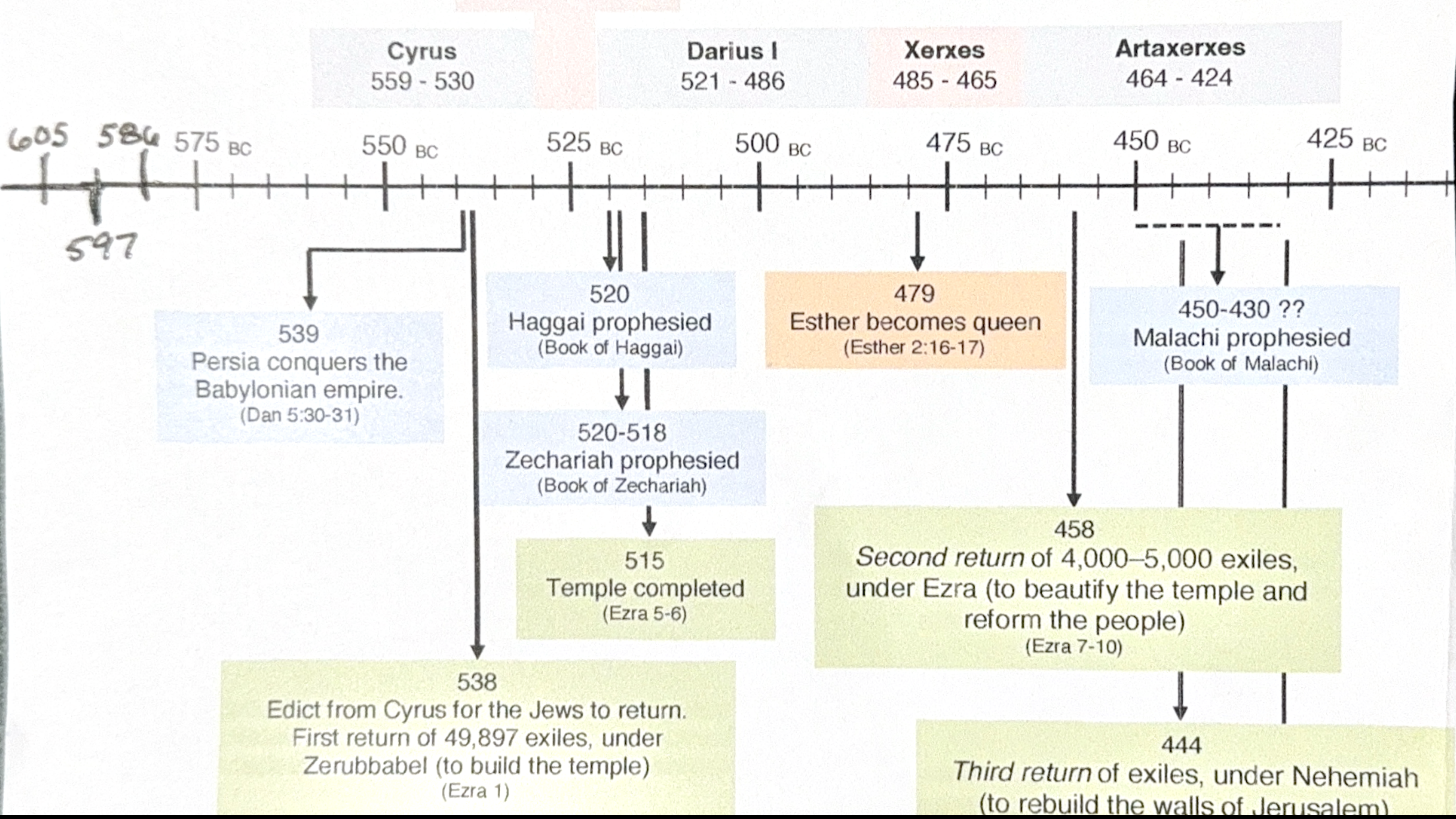

- 605** First wave of exiles taken to Babylon
- 597** King Jehoiachin & other leaders exile
- 586** Nebuchadnezzar destroys Jerusalem & Temple
- 539** Cyrus conquers Babylon
- 538** Cyrus' decree for the Jews to return
 - Led by Zerubbabel to build Altar & Temple
- 515** Second Temple completed
- 458** Second return led by Ezra
- 445** Third return led by Nehemiah to rebuild the walls
