

LIFE GROUP GUIDE – Week Starting Sunday 26th May 2024

Key passage: 1 Corinthians 10:23-11:1

BIG IDEA: In this section of Corinthians we are reminded of the importance of community (one of our 7 values as a church). In this passage we're finishing up Paul's argument about whether or not to eat meat that has been sacrificed to idols. He finishes by making a broader point - that in whatever we do we should be seeking the good of others, not of ourselves.

Fixing our eyes on God

Read Psalm 146 together to be reminded of the goodness of God.

Opening God's word

Read together 1 Corinthians 10:23 - 11:1.

1. We've been speaking about eating food sacrificed to idols for a few weeks now - why was this such a big question for the Corinthians?
2. What are some modern equivalents of meat sacrificed to idols? Are they things you need to avoid?
3. Paul sums up his arguments before and against in verse 31 - why is glorifying God the most important thing?
4. Why does Paul say he is trying to please everyone, in every way?
5. What does 'seeking the good of others' look like for you this week?

Time to pray

Pray for one another:

1. That you would bear with one another in love, supporting one another in your walk with Christ.
2. That you would glorify God in your actions this week - whether you are eating or drinking or whatever you do!
