This Week's BIG IDEA: One-anothering, influencing and being influenced. "Imitate me."

Opening the topic

What's your relationship with your earthly father like? Do you know him as someone who administered strong discipline, or more of a gentle spirit?

Opening God's word

Read together 1 Corinthians 4:14-21

- 1. Should Paul have come directly to Corinth to sort out the issues there himself, rather than sending Timothy?
- 2. What does Paul mean when he says "imitate me"?
 - Note: Look at what he says earlier in the chapter (4:1, 4:9-13)
- 3. Read Luke 9:28-36 (transfiguration), Luke 8:51-56 (raising the girl from the dead), and Mark 14:32-42 (Gethsemane).
 - Jesus intentionally chose the 12 disciples, but it is also clear from these verses that He selected Peter, James and John from among them to be His "inner circle".
 - Why did He choose 3 from the among the 12 in this particular way?
 - Can you name the Peter, James, and John in your life? If not, what might your walk with God might look like if you could?
- 4. When should leaders in the church use the "rod of discipline"? (v21)

Time to pray

- Pray that this group would be a place of one-anothering to each other.
- You could break into smaller groups of 2-3 people and ask each other for specifics of what you can pray for each other, or support one another in.
- Don't forget to pray for those who couldn't make it to the group for any reason.
