#### **Opening the topic**

Which leaders have you admired? Not just public or historical figures but leaders from school, family, church, work etc. What is it about the way they led that you admired?

# **Opening God's word**

Read together 1 Corinthians 4:1-13

- 1. How does Paul describe himself as a leader in v1?
  - Apostle 'one who is sent', preaching the gospel, planting and building up churches
  - Servant under/lower rower slave rowing in the lowest deck of a three-tiered Trireme (Greek/Roman warship), working hard to advance the church
  - Steward will be called to account
- 2. How does Paul describe the Corinthians in vv 6-8? uses sarcasm, calls them out for boasting
- 3. How does Paul describe the Apostles in vv 9-13? leaders who go low
- 4. READ John 13:1-5, 12-17 what does this show us about Jesus' leadership?
- 5. READ Isaiah 53:3-8 how far did Jesus' servant leadership take him? What does this look like for us in school, work (paid/unpaid), family, church?
