LIFE GROUP GUIDE 1 Corinthians 1:1-25

This Week's BIG IDEA: This week we begin to unpack 1 Corinthians chapter 1 on the basis of the foundation we laid last week. Over the coming weeks we will be looking at the first of the big themes in the letter – Unity in the church. Paul has been made aware that there is disunity in the church which is revealing itself through personality cults. Different groups are putting their trust and dependence on individual leaders or a super spiritual emphasis on Christ. Even though Paul is one of the people they are attaching themselves too, he will have none of it. This week Paul unearths the root of their disunity – PRIDE.
