# LIFE GROUP GUIDE wb 30<sup>th</sup> June 2024 Key passage 1 Corinthians 12-14

<u>This Week's BIG IDEA</u>: We are approaching the end of our Corinthian series. This week we'll be revisiting spiritual gifts whilst also taking a closer look at the gift of tongues and prophecy. Together we'll ask the question, what are these gifts and how do they work? Also, what are their purpose and how will these gifts help me build up the church for both believers and unbelievers.?

### Opening God's word

Read together 1 Corinthians 14

- 1. From vs 1-5 what can we say bout the gift of tongues and prophesy, what are your personal thoughts about these 2 gifts? Why does Paul elevate one over the other?
- 2. Do these gifts have a place in the modern-day church, based on 1 Corinthians 13:11-12?
- 3. Based on vs 22-25 who are the gifts of Tongues and Prophesy for and what is the impact of their use?
- 4. What has been your personal experience of spiritual gifts to date? Positive and negatives?
- 5. Does your experience match the service described in from vs 26-33? If so, what was your initial emotional reaction?
- 6. Based on vs 34-40 How can Men and Women of God honour him with their spiritual gifts?

## Time to pray

Spiritual gifts can seem a bit daunting and place people a little outside their comfort zone. But gaining understanding and trusting God regarding the nature of his gifts; can lead us to a place of immense freedom and a clearer view of God in our lives. Let us Pray for one another to embrace and exercise gifts given to us by the father. Pray for God to bring a fresh outpouring of his holy spirit upon the group and leave space for a hymn, a word, a revelation, a tongue or an interpretation.
