

IF – Forgiveness

IF - is a conjunction that introduces a conditional statement, meaning "on the condition that". It can also mean "whether," introduce a polite request, or be used to suggest an imaginary situation

(Luke 17:1-10 nlt)

- As followers of Jesus. Forgiveness is our duty. Its something that we must do. We have no choice. If they ask for forgiveness, we have to forgive
- When a believer sins against you. You go to them privately to point out the offense
- There is protocol before counting a believer out the fellowship and there is also consequences if you don't want to be reconcile

(Matthew 18:15-35 nlt)

- The reason most people don't want to be reconcile or forgive is because of anger. God want you first to reconcile, before you even bring a gift to the altar **(Matthew 5:21-26 nkjv)**
- Jesus even taught us in the Lords prayer to forgive others as we are forgiven. If we don't forgive our heavenly father wont forgive us

(Matthew 6:9-15 nlt)

- You have a chose to be offended. As Gods Holy people he loves. You must clothe yourself with tenderhearted mercy, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. Making allowance for each other faults

(Colossians 3:12-15 nlt)

- Holding on to unforgiveness is our old sinful nature. We must live as children of light and not as gentiles do. **(Ephesians 4:17-32 nlt)**
