

Roles – As a Soldier of Christ

Roles - the specific function, job, duty, or part you have in a situation, organization, relationship, or society, defining your expected behavior, responsibilities, and purpose.

God has called every believer into his army. Scripture tells us to fight the good fight of faith.

Because we have an enemy that wants to kill, steal and destroy you. God tells us to put on the full armour of God, so that you can stand against the strategies of the devil (**Ephesians 6:10-18 nlt**)

- If the bible is telling us to put on the full armor of God, then God is preparing us for a battle. Only soldiers put on armor to go to war, so God is enlisting us into his army.
- You are called to be a soldier for Christ, the difference is, are you going to be a prepared or unprepared soldier. Are you going to be a good one or bad one. Regardless you have been enlisted! (**2 Timothy 2:1-14 nlt**)
- They say when you at war, you're fighting for the person next to you. Trying to survive and make it home. Putting your life on the line for your brother in arms.
- The bible tells us that there is no greater love than to lay one's life down for a friend (**John 15:12-13 nlt**)
- There is a time for everything. A time for peace and a time for war (**Ecclesiastes 3:1-8 nlt**)

- When God preserves and prospers his people he will train you for battle
(Psalms 144:1-2 nlt)
- God will use someone who has a fight in them to lead. Moses was a killer, Joshua was the captain the moses army, Samson was a Judge, David was a warrior, Peter was cutting ears off, and Paul was killing Christians.
- When the Israelites were about to enter the promise land. He chose Joshua to do it. A soldier to lead Gods people into the promise
- God has a promise for you but a soldier is needed to enter it. Today God is still making the same command he told Joshua. Be strong and courageous **(Joshua 1:6-9 nlt)**
- When God is building or restoring what was destroyed. a fight will come. But when they fight comes don't stop building. Fight while you build!
