

Weakness – Finding Grace

Weakness – the state or condition of lacking strength, the quality of being weak. A person or thing that one is unable to resist or likes excessively

(Hebrews 4:14-16 nlt)

- The role of the high priest was to act as a mediator between God and the people, offering sacrifices for sins.
- And once a year he will enter the holy of Holies on the day of Atonement to perform a ritual with sacrificial blood to atone for the sins of the people and his own household.
- Jesus is now our high priest, and the lamb that God that was sacrificed to forgive our sins.
- And because he is our high priest he can sympathizes with our weakness. He understands us because he himself was tested but he never sinned.
- Because he understand our weakness. We can come boldly to the throne of grace to obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Why is grace important in weakness?

(2 Corinthians 12:7-10 nlt)

- The Lord said “My grace is all you need. My power works best in weakness”
- NKJV translation says my grace is sufficient for you. For my strength is made perfect in weakness

- The Lord needs weakness for his strength to be made perfect.
- The Lord didn't take away the throne in his flesh. even tho Paul prayed three times to do so.
- His grace is all he needed. The strength to overcome weakness
- Remember where sin abounds, grace abounds much more
(Romans 5:20)
- God gives grace to the humble. Therefore submit to God resist the devil and he will flee from you **(James 4:6-7 nlt)**
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
