

Weakness – Weak Conscience

Weakness – the state or condition of lacking strength, the quality of being weak. A person or thing that one is unable to resist or likes excessively

(1 Corinthians 8:1-13 nlt)

- Many from the church in Corinth, were converts from idol worshippers
- It was their custom for to offer food to their idols and false gods
- They truly believed they were real
- Now that they got saved, their conscience is weak because their mind hasn't been renewed yet and they still believe the idols are real
- The bible tells us that we must present our bodies as a living sacrifice and not to conform to this world but be transformed by the renewing of the mind **(Romans 12:1-3 nlt)**

- As believers we must understand that some believers have weak consciences, who are weak in faith and are super sensitive. But they also belong to the Lord, and we shouldn't criticism them

(Romans 14:1-23 nlt)

- We who are strong must be considerate of those who are sensitive

(Romans 15:1-13 nlt)

- When a person is corrupt or unbelieving. You corrupt your conscience as well and you become worthless for doing anything good

(Titus 1:15-16 nlt)

- The purpose of Paul's instructions is that all believers would be filled with love that comes from a pure heart, a clear conscience and genuine faith **(1 Timothy 1:3-11 nlt)**
- Scripture tells us to warn those who are lazy, encourage those who are timid, take care of those who are weak and be patient with everyone **(1 Thessalonians 5:14-22 nlt)**
