The Fear of Lord – A deep, reverent awe and loving respect for Gods supreme power and holiness

The fear of the Lord preserves you and brings protection into your life

(Job 1:6-11 nlt)

⁶One day the members of the heavenly court^[a] came to present themselves before the Lord, and the Accuser, Satan,^[b] came with them. ⁷“Where have you come from?” the Lord asked Satan.

Satan answered the Lord, “I have been patrolling the earth, watching everything that’s going on.”

⁸Then the Lord asked Satan, “Have you noticed my servant Job? He is the finest man in all the earth. He is blameless—a man of complete integrity. He fears God and stays away from evil.”

⁹Satan replied to the Lord, “Yes, but Job has good reason to fear God. ¹⁰You have always put a wall of protection around him and his home and his property. You have made him prosper in everything he does. Look how rich he is! ¹¹But reach out and take away everything he has, and he will surely curse you to your face!”

- Job was a blessed man and prospered because he feared the Lord
- True humility and fear of the Lord lead to riches, honor, and long life.

(Proverbs 22:4 nlt)

- when you fear the Lord and put your trust in him. you will lack no good thing

(Psalms 34:8-10 nlt)

Taste and see that the Lord is good. Oh, the joys of those who take refuge in him!⁹ Fear the Lord, you his godly people, for those who fear him will have all they need. ¹⁰ Even strong young lions sometimes go hungry, but those who trust in the Lord will lack no good thing.

- The fear of the Lord Brings protection and shelter but also has goodness he stored up for those who fear him

(Psalms 31:19-20 nlt)

¹⁹ How great is the goodness you have stored up for those who fear you. You lavish it on those who come to you for protection, blessing them before the watching world.²⁰ You hide them in the shelter of your presence, safe from those who conspire against them. You shelter them in your presence, far from accusing tongues.

- being rich and being blessed is different. Lacking nothing means there is no want.
- It's better to have the fear of the lord with little than to have great treasures and inner turmoil

(Proverbs 15:16-17 nlt)

Better to have little, with fear for the Lord, than to have great treasure and inner turmoil.¹⁷ A bowl of vegetables with someone you love is better than steak with someone you hate.

- Don't envy sinners continue to fear the Lord God will reward you for this

(Proverbs 23:17-18 nlt)

Don't envy sinners but always continue to fear the Lord.¹⁸ You will be rewarded for this; your hope will not be disappointed.

- The fear of the Lord not only affects you but it also affects your household

(Psalms 128:1-6 nlt)

How joyful are those who fear the Lord—all who follow his ways! ²You will enjoy the fruit of your labor. How joyful and prosperous you will be!

³Your wife will be like a fruitful grapevine, flourishing within your home.

Your children will be like vigorous young olive trees as they sit around

your table.⁴That is the Lord's blessing for those who fear him. ⁵May

the Lord continually bless you from Zion. May you see Jerusalem prosper

as long as you live.⁶ May you live to enjoy your grandchildren. May Israel

have peace!

- If you want the recognition of a proverbs 31 woman. Women you must fear the Lord too

(Proverbs 31:30-31 nlt)

³⁰Charm is deceptive, and beauty does not last; but a woman who fears

the Lord will be greatly praised.³¹ Reward her for all she has done. Let her

deeds publicly declare her praise.

- Those who fear the Lord he will show them which path they should take and that path is a prosperous one leading to being a friend to the Lord

(Psalms 25:11-14 nlt)

For the honor of your name, O Lord, forgive my many, many sins.

¹²Who are those who fear the Lord? He will show them the path they should choose.¹³They will live in prosperity, and their children will inherit the land.¹⁴The Lord is a friend to those who fear him. He teaches them his covenant.

- the Lord's delight is in those who fear him, those who put their hope in his unfailing love.

(Psalms 147:7-11 nlt)

Sing out your thanks to the Lord; sing praises to our God with a harp.

⁸He covers the heavens with clouds, provides rain for the earth, and makes the grass grow in mountain pastures.⁹He gives food to the wild animals and feeds the young ravens when they cry. ¹⁰He takes no pleasure in the strength of a horse or in human might.¹¹No, the Lord's delight is in those who fear him, those who put their hope in his unfailing love.

- Not only does the fear of the Lord give you wisdom, life, protection, prosperity. It also gives you health to your flesh and strength to your bones

(Proverbs 3:5-8 nlt)

⁵Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. ⁶Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take ⁷Don't be impressed with your own wisdom. Instead, fear the Lord and turn away from evil. ⁸Then you will have healing for your body and strength for your bones.

- There are so many blessing and benefits to have the fear of the Lord, you can't afford not to have it

(Psalms 112:1-10 nlt)

¹Praise the Lord! How joyful are those who fear the Lord and delight in obeying his commands.²Their children will be successful everywhere; an entire generation of godly people will be blessed.³They themselves will be wealthy, and their good deeds will last forever.⁴Light shines in the darkness for the godly. They are generous, compassionate, and righteous.⁵Good comes to those who lend money generously and conduct their business fairly.⁶Such people will not be overcome by evil. Those who are righteous will be long remembered. ⁷They do not fear bad news; they confidently trust the Lord to care for them.⁸They are confident and fearless and can face their foes triumphantly.⁹They share freely and give generously to those in need. Their good deeds will be remembered forever. They will have influence and honor.¹⁰The wicked will see this and be infuriated. They will grind their teeth in anger; they will slink away, their hopes thwarted.

- Remember, the 7 spirits of God. The Holy Spirit describe in 7 ways.
The Spirit of the Lord is his delight
- The Prophet Isaiah prophesied that the fear of the Lord will be our treasure

(Isaiah 33:5-6 nlt)

⁵Though the Lord is very great and lives in heaven, he will make Jerusalem^[b] his home of justice and righteousness.⁶ In that day he will be your sure foundation, providing a rich store of salvation, wisdom, and knowledge. The fear of the Lord will be your treasure.
