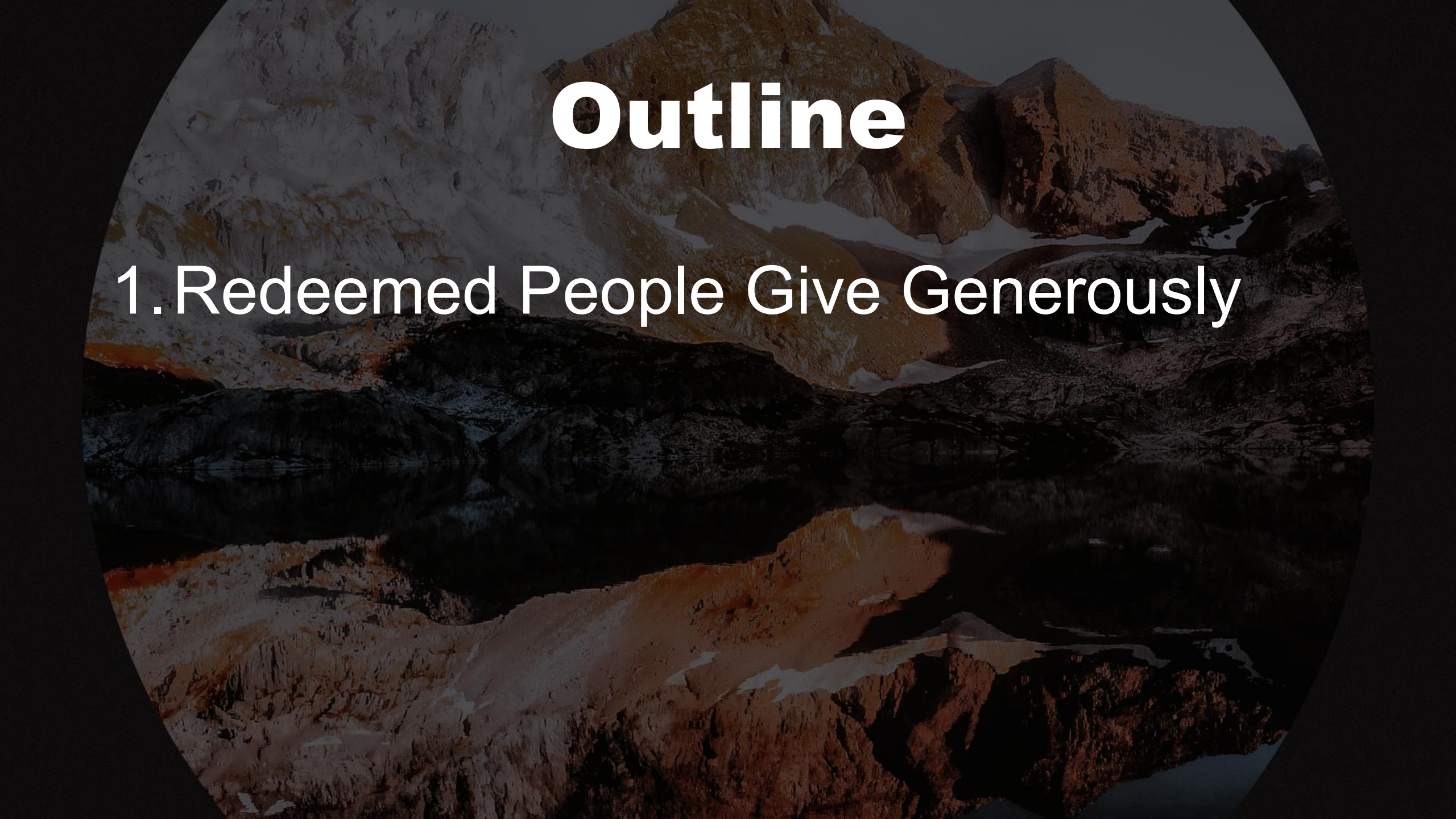
Ephesians 2:8-10

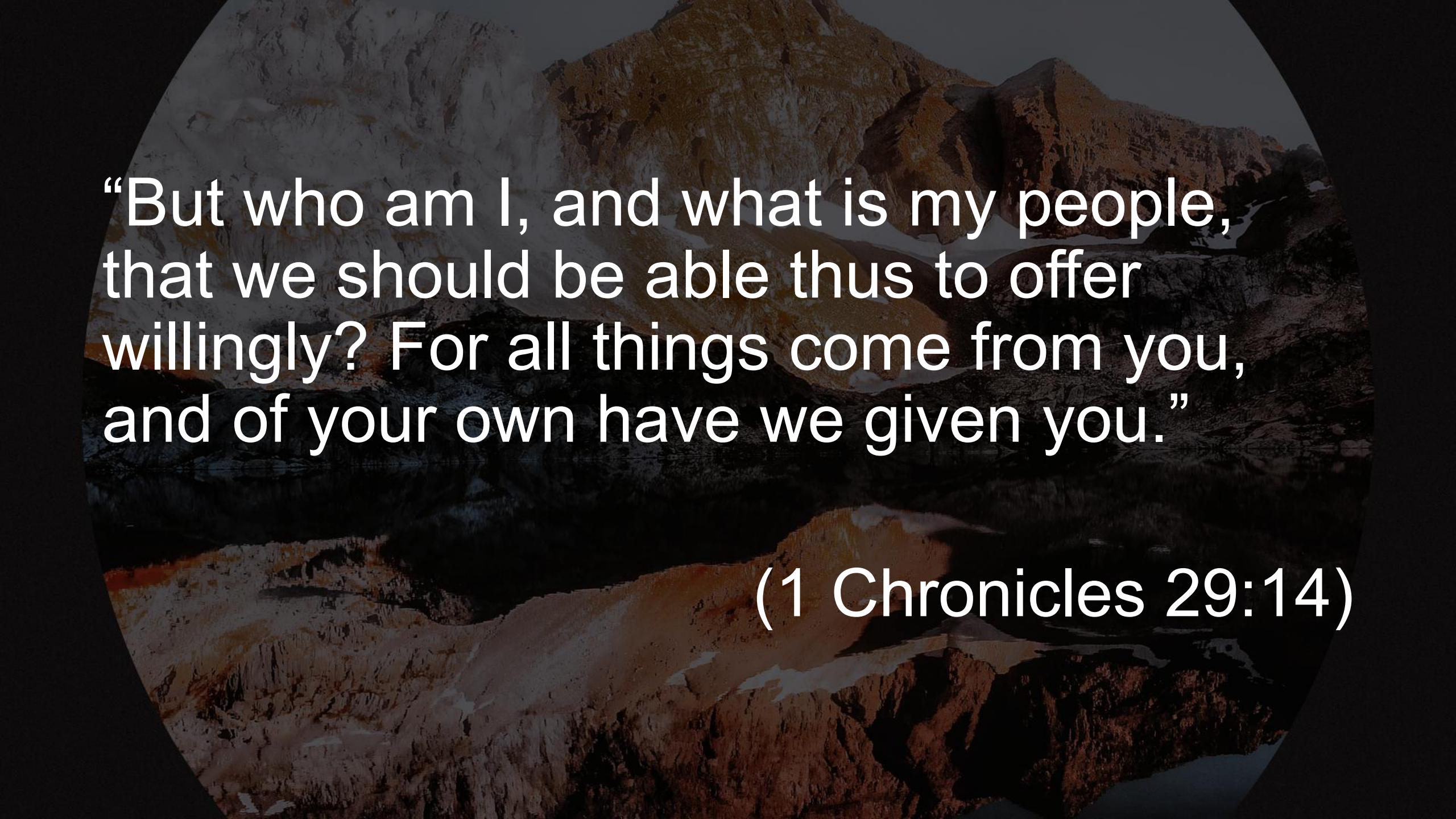
1. Redeemed People Give Generously

[21] And they came, everyone whose heart stirred him, and everyone whose spirit moved him, and brought the LORD's contribution to be used for the tent of meeting, and for all its service, and for the holy garments. [22] So they came, both men and women...

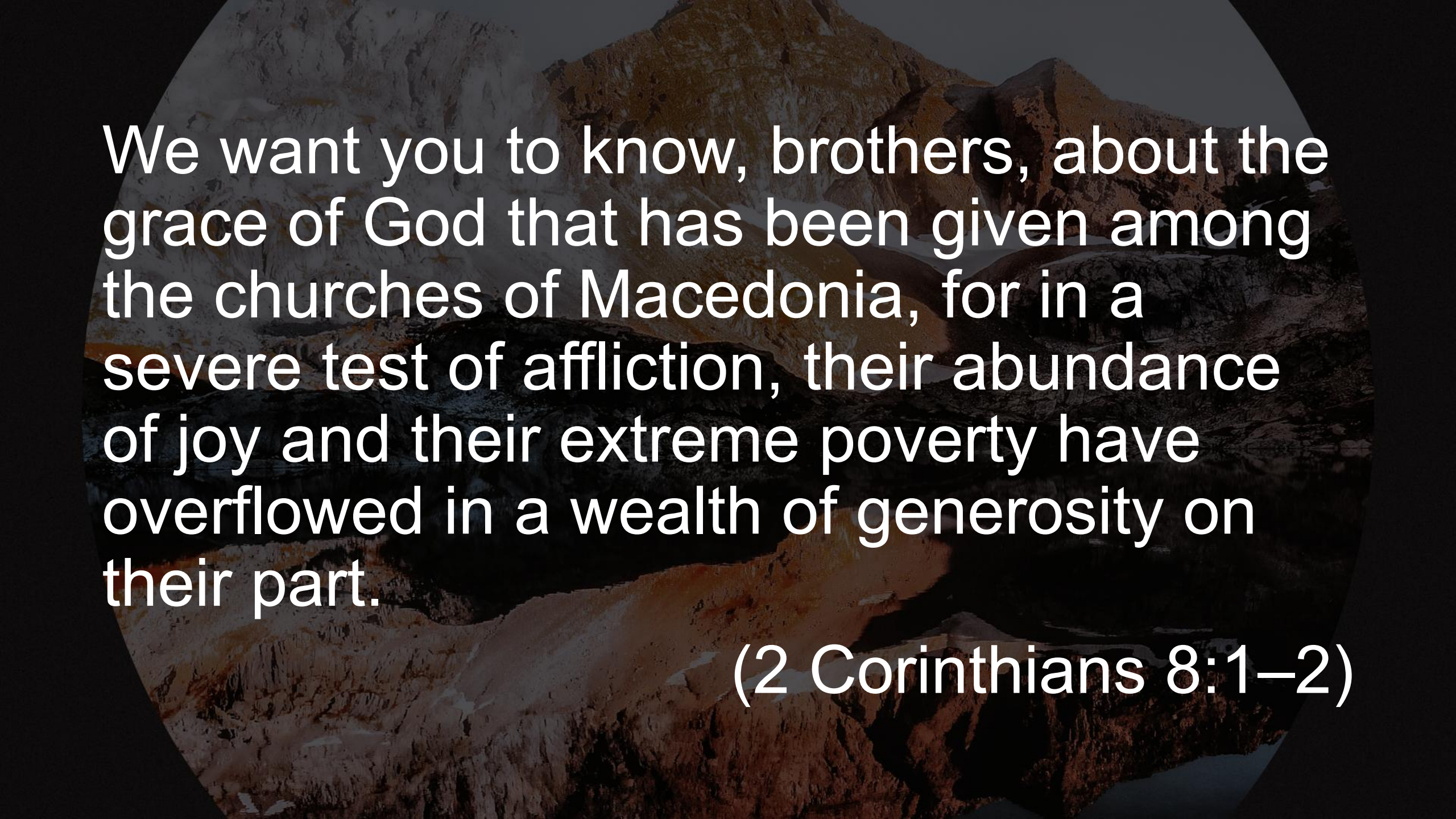
Exodus 35:21-23

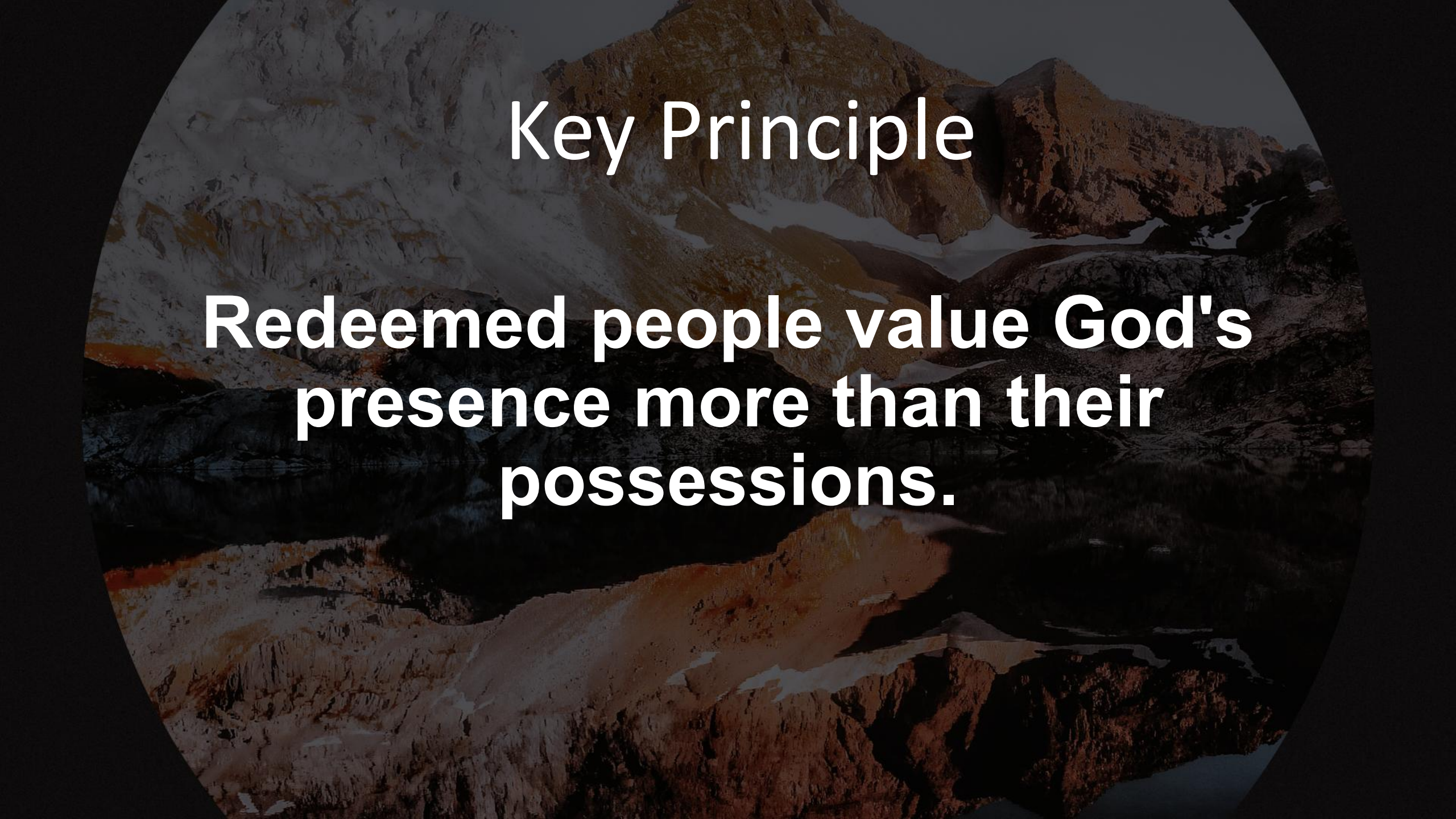
“But who am I, and what is my people,

(1 Chronicles 29:14)



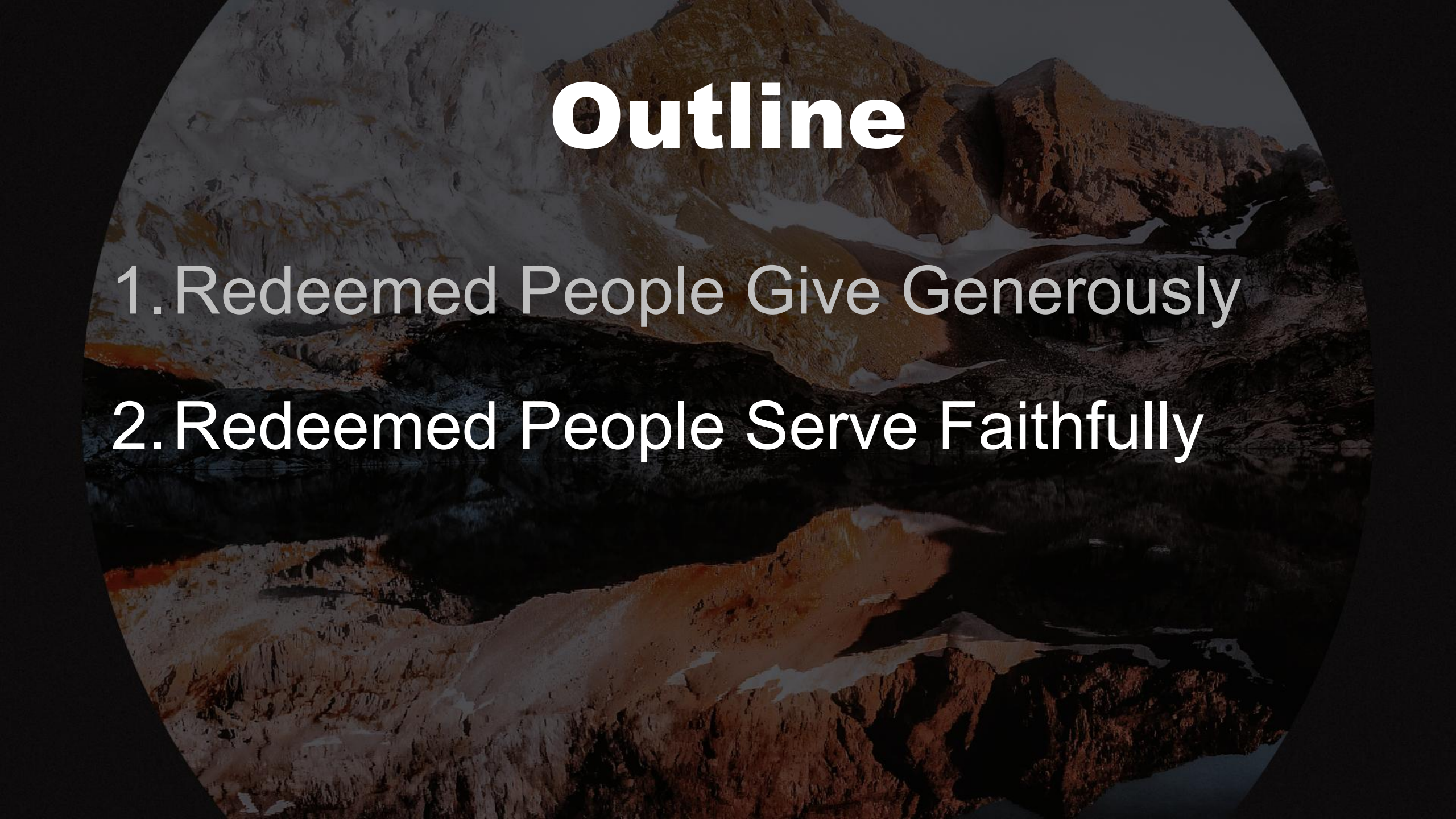

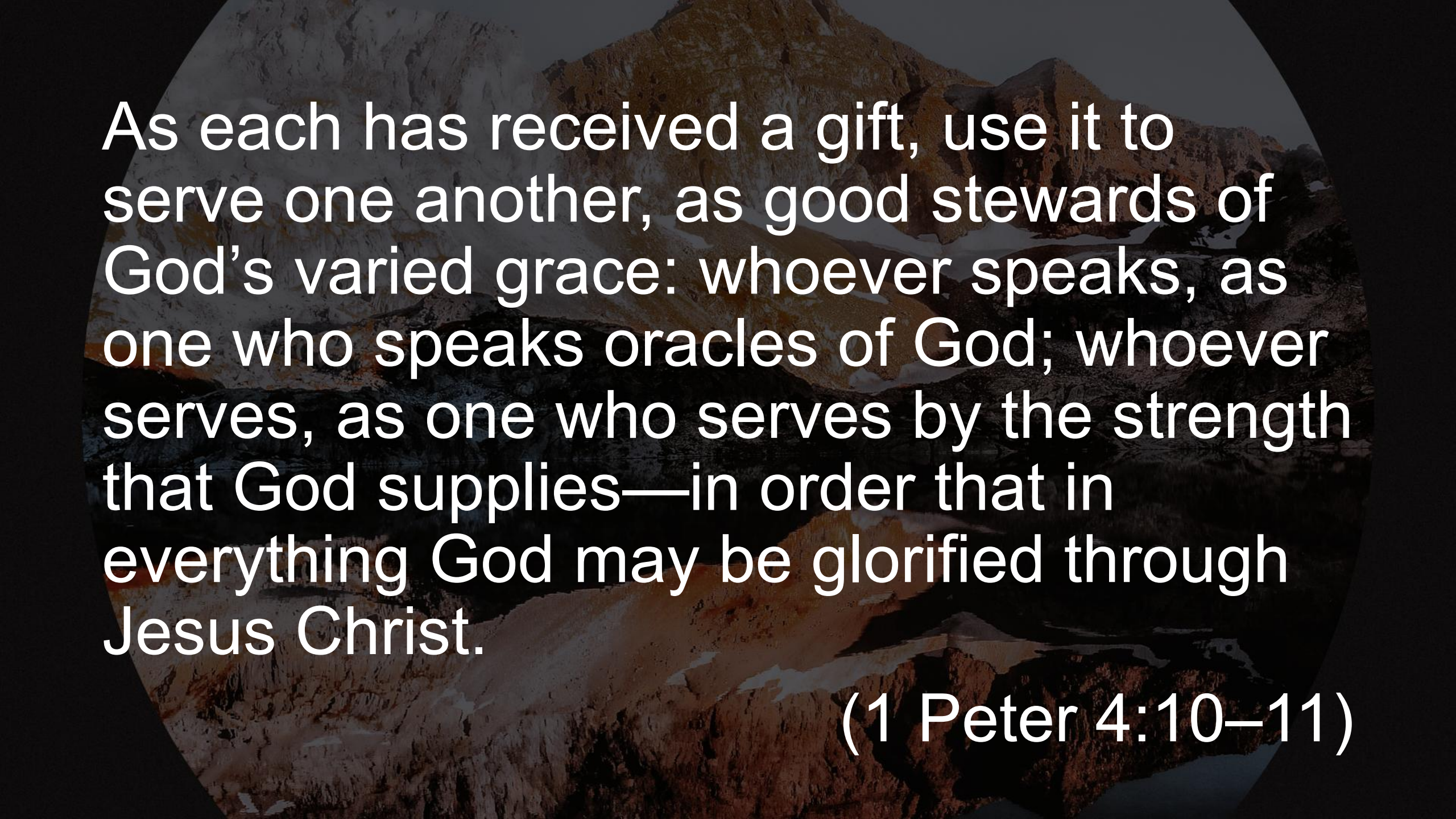
2. Redeemed People Serve Faithfully

Exodus 39:1-5

[1] From the blue and purple and scarlet yarns they made finely woven garments, for ministering in the Holy Place... [2] He made the ephod of gold, blue and purple and scarlet yarns, and fine twined linen.

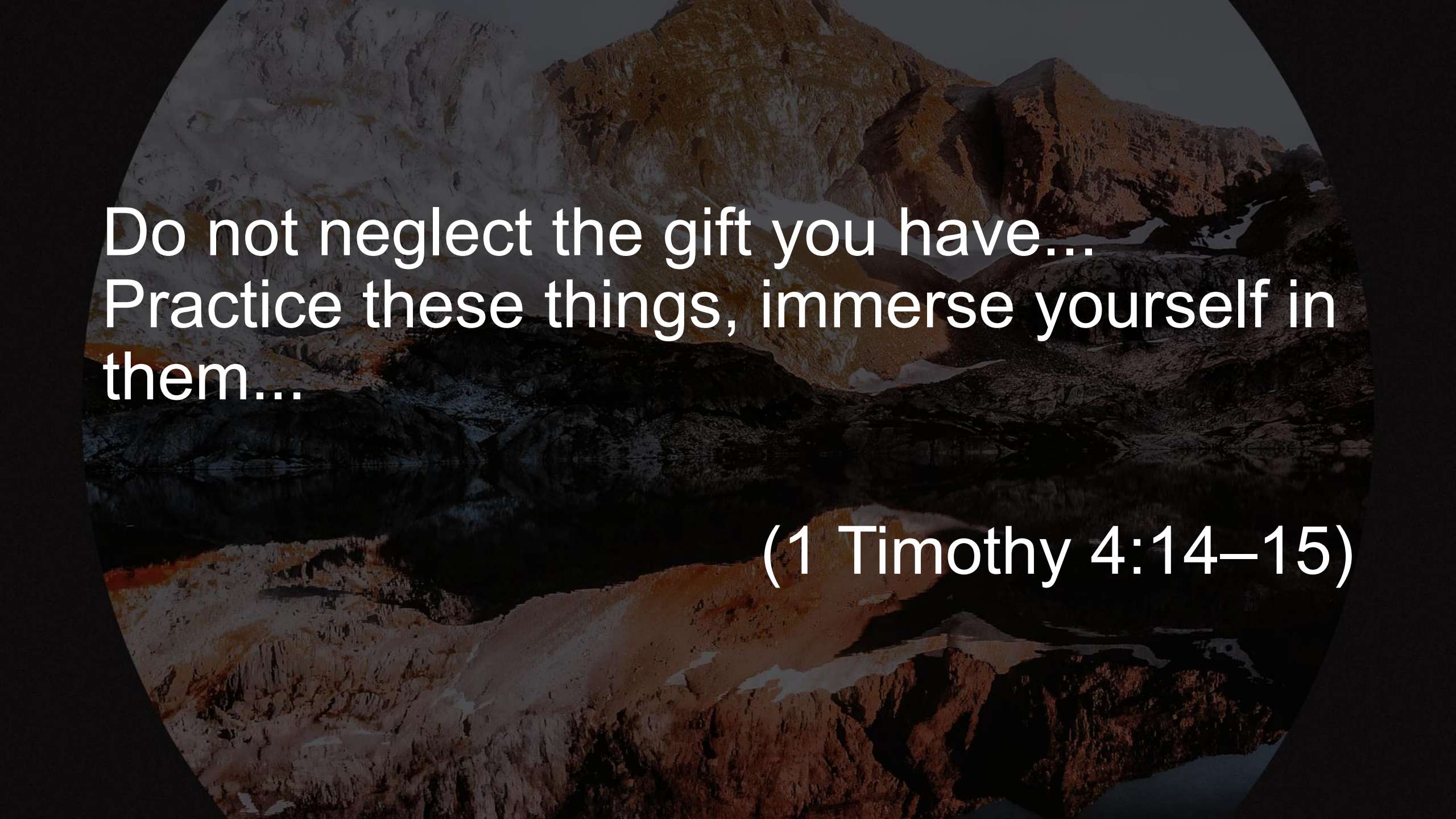
Exodus 39:1-5

[3] And they hammered out gold leaf, and he cut it into threads to work into the blue and purple and the scarlet yarns, and into the fine twined linen, in skilled design. [4] They made for the ephod attaching shoulder pieces, joined to it at its two edges. [5] And the skillfully woven band on it was of one piece with it...

(1 Peter 4:10–11)



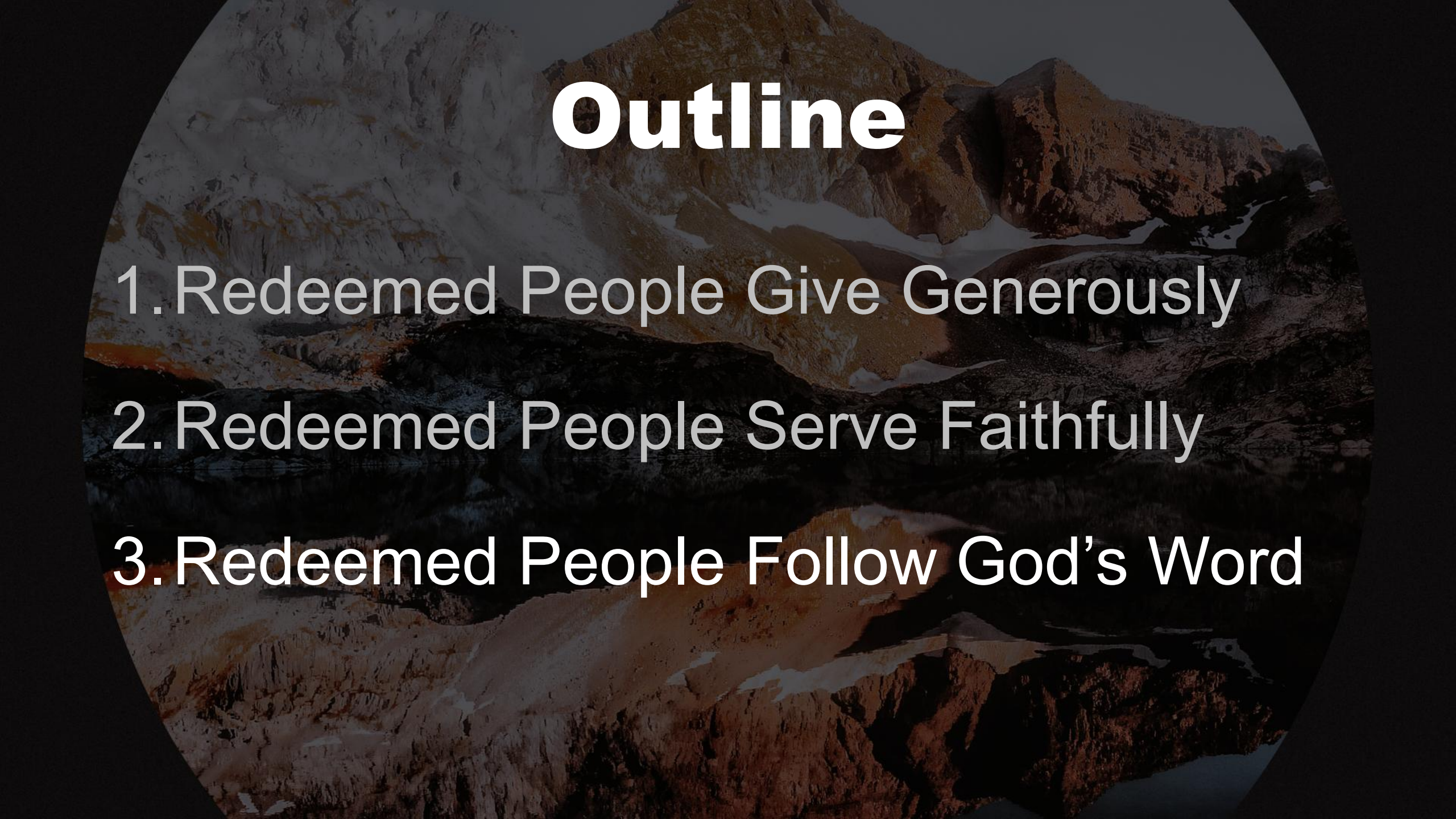

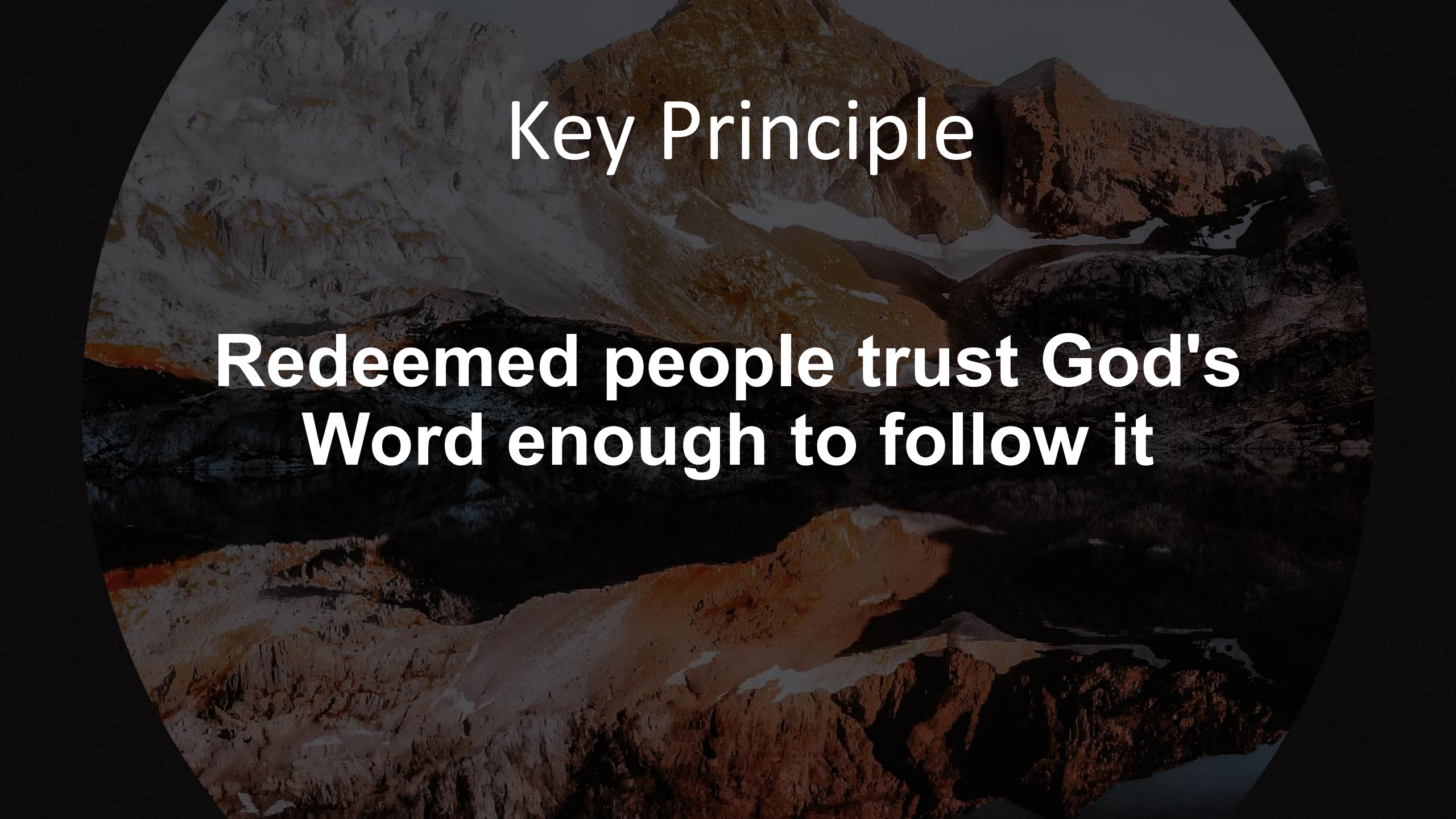
3. Redeemed People Follow God's Word

Exodus 39:32, 42-43

[32] Thus all the work of the tabernacle of the tent of meeting was finished, and the people of Israel did **according to all that the LORD had commanded Moses...** [42] **According to all that the LORD had commanded Moses**, so the people of Israel had done all the work. [43] And Moses saw all the work, and behold, they had done it; **as the LORD had commanded**, so had they done it. Then Moses blessed them.

New Testament Commands

- Jesus told his disciples that “*if they loved him, they would obey his commandments*” (Jn. 14:15).
- Paul wrote to the Ephesians to “*live in a manner worthy of the calling they had received*” (Eph. 4:1).
- Peter wrote to believers who were born again to a living hope that they should live as “*obedient children*” (1 Pet. 1:14).
- James told believers not to be “*hearers of the word only, but doers*” (Jas. 1:22-25).
