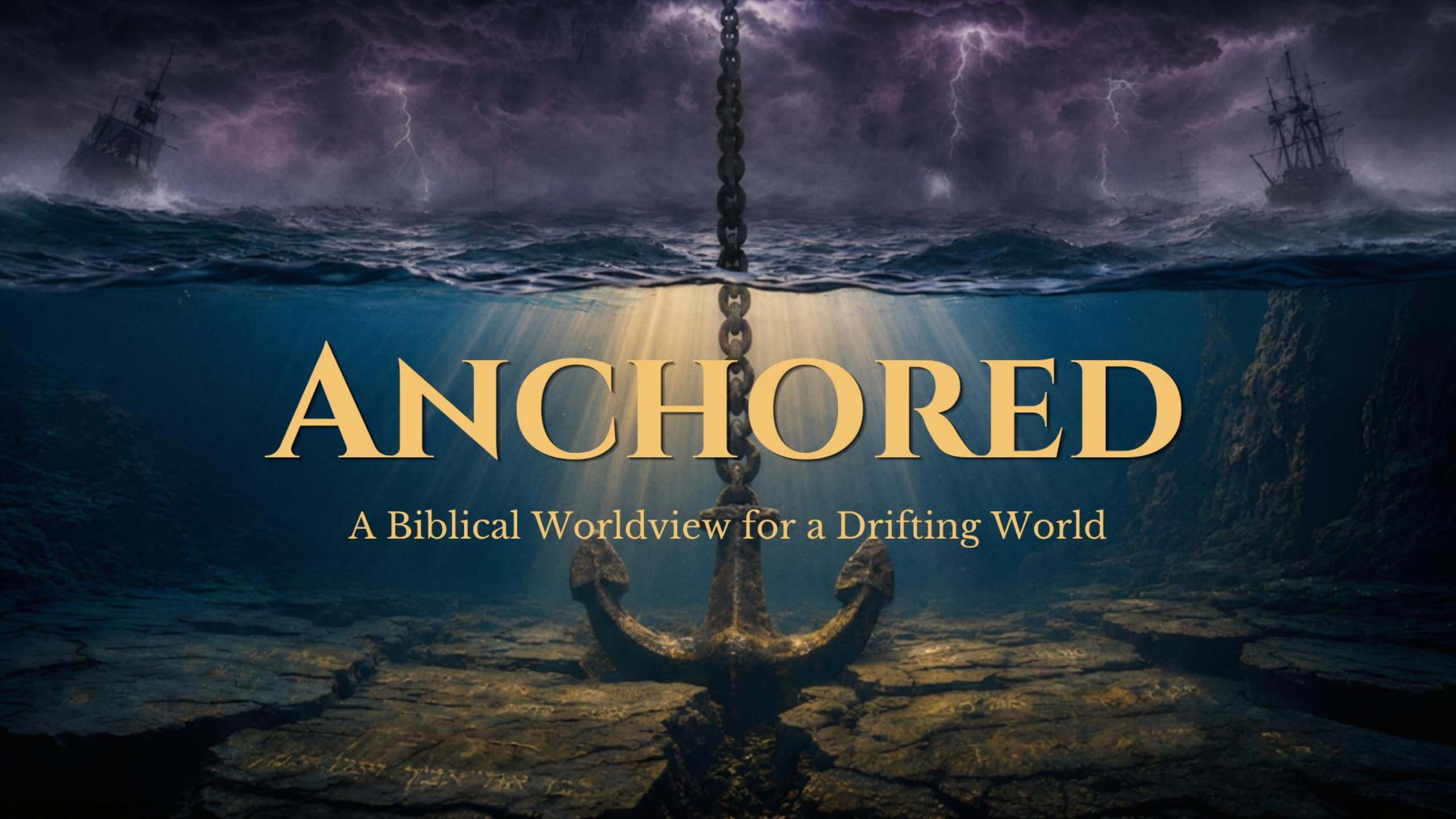

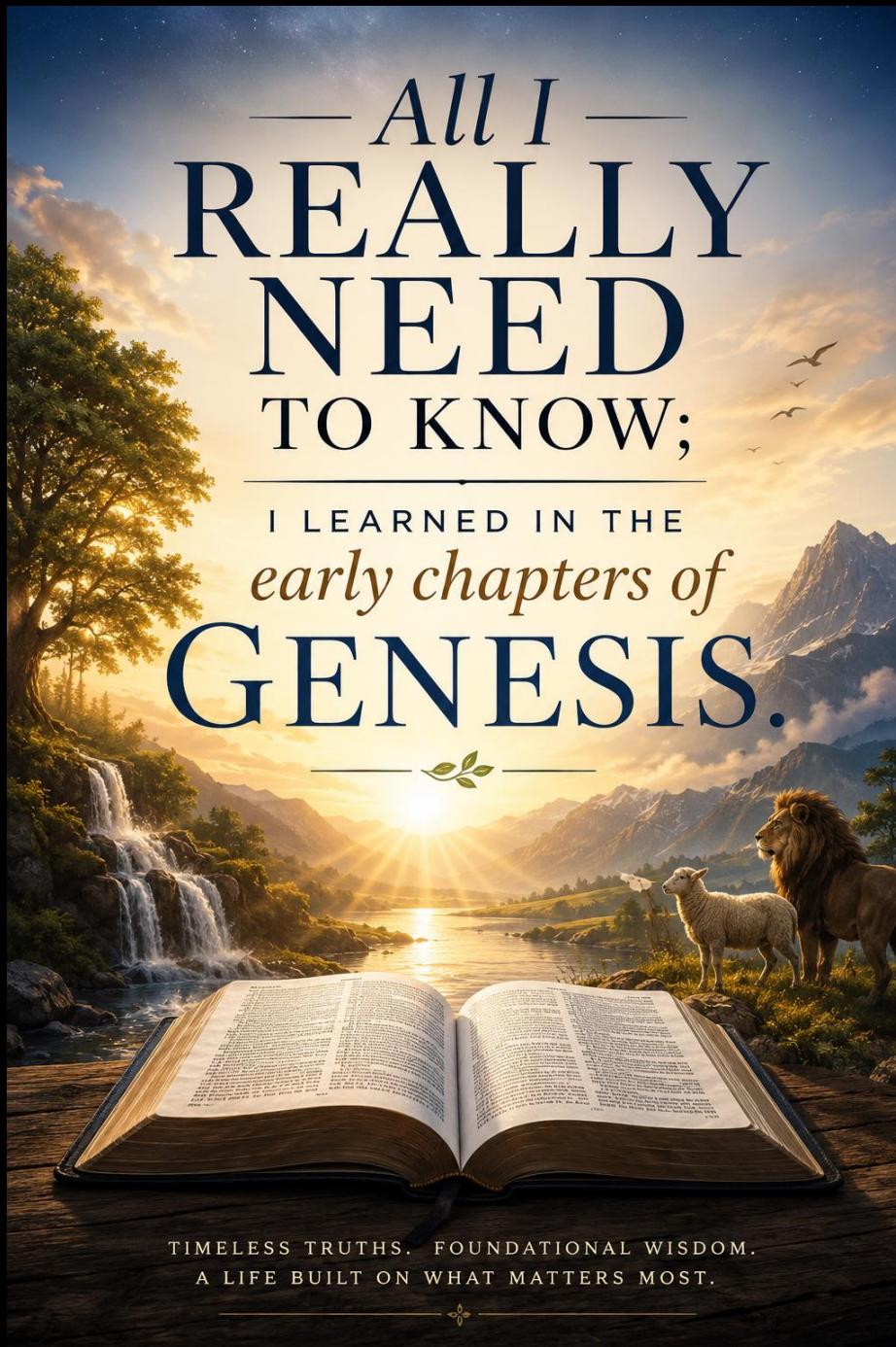

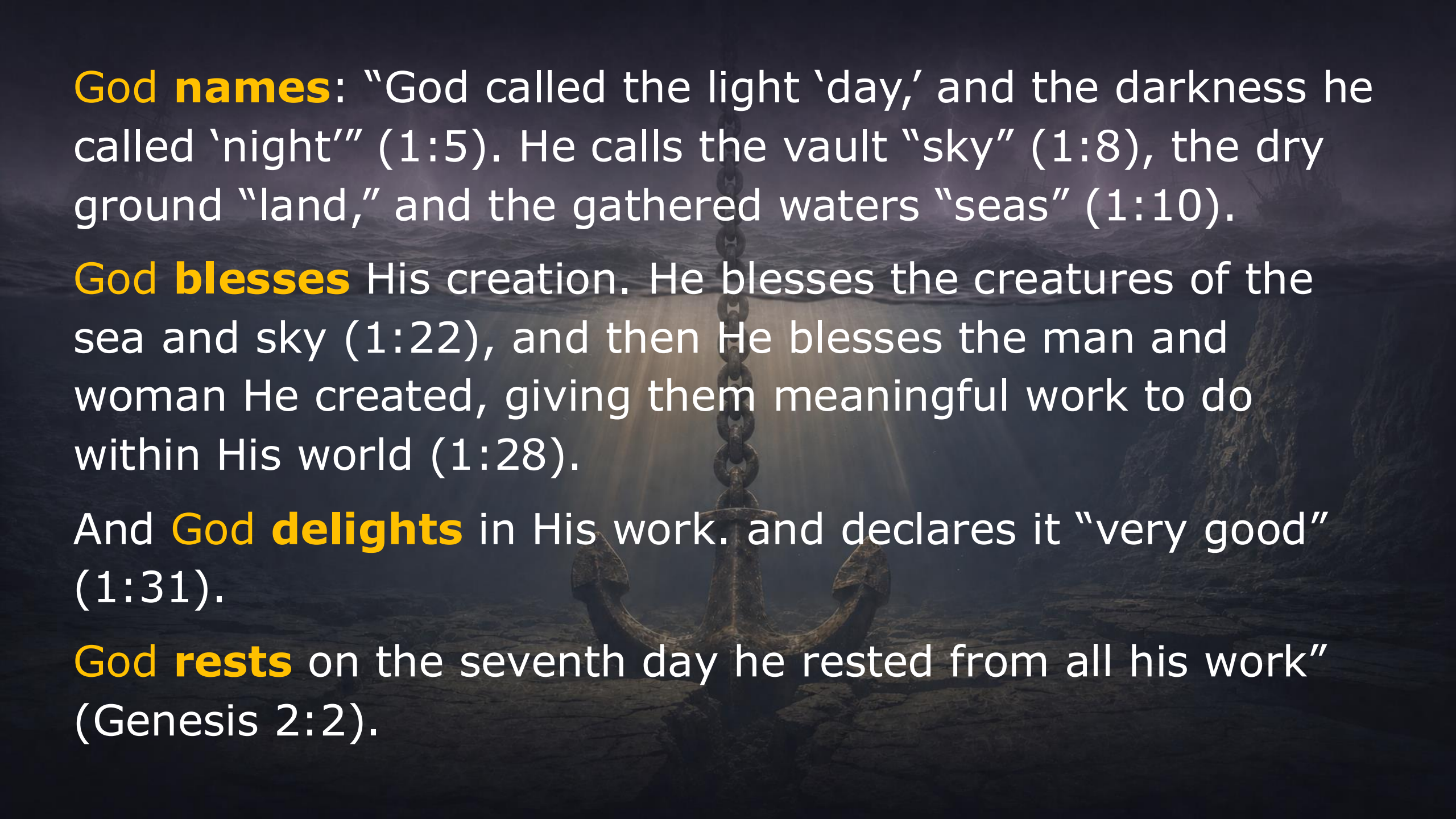
1. God is a Person: He can be known.

“And **God said...**” (Genesis 1:3, 6, 9, 11, 14, 20, 24, 26).

God speaks: “Let there be light,” and there was light (Genesis 1:3).

God sees: “God saw that it was good” (Genesis 1:10, 12, 18, 21, 25, 31).

God acts: He separates the light from darkness (1:4), gathers the waters together (1:9), makes the sun, moon, and stars (1:16), and creates mankind in His own image (1:27).



God names: "God called the light 'day,' and the darkness he called 'night'" (1:5). He calls the vault "sky" (1:8), the dry ground "land," and the gathered waters "seas" (1:10).

God blesses His creation. He blesses the creatures of the sea and sky (1:22), and then He blesses the man and woman He created, giving them meaningful work to do within His world (1:28).

And **God delights** in His work, and declares it "very good" (1:31).

God rests on the seventh day he rested from all his work" (Genesis 2:2).

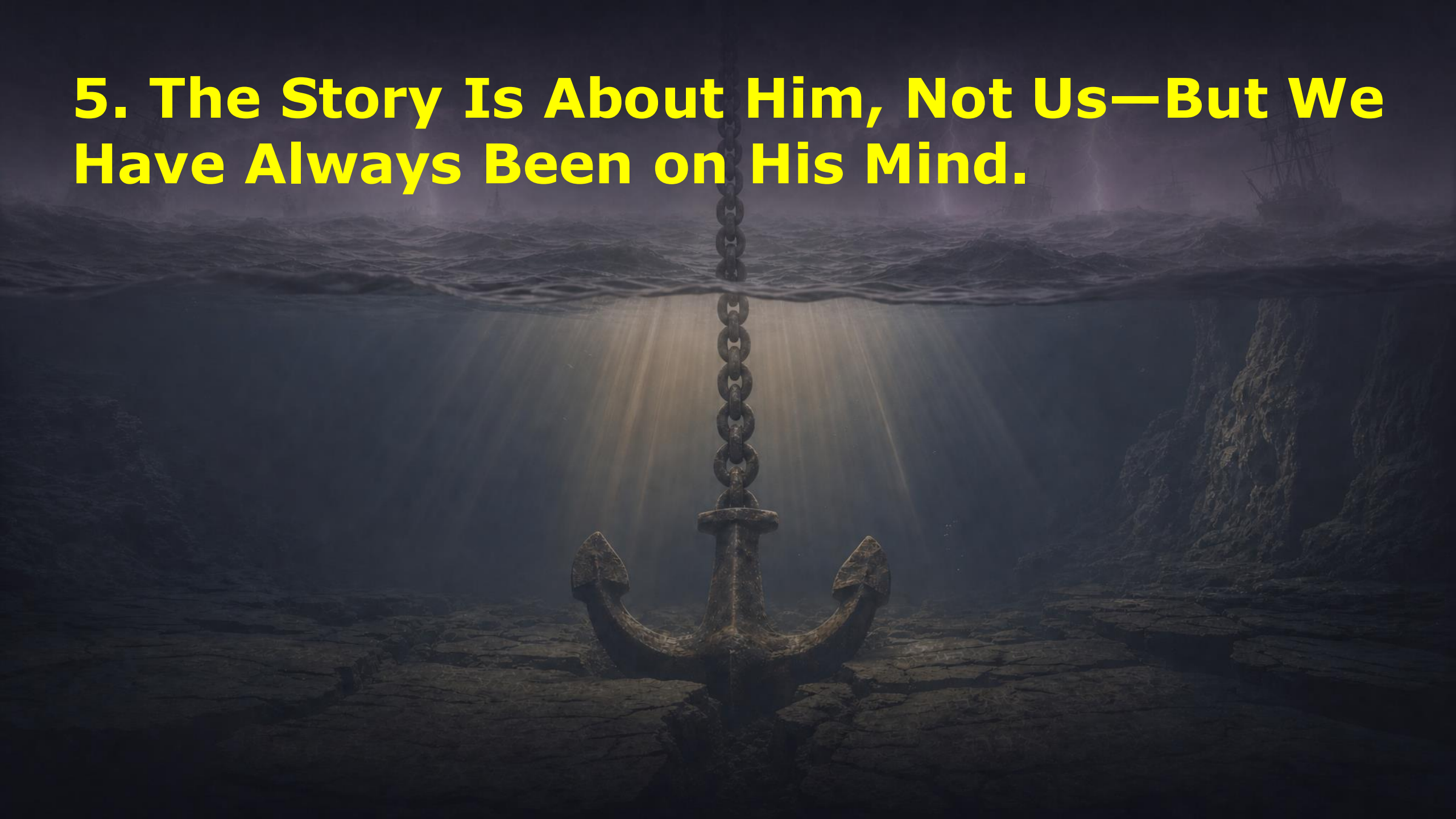

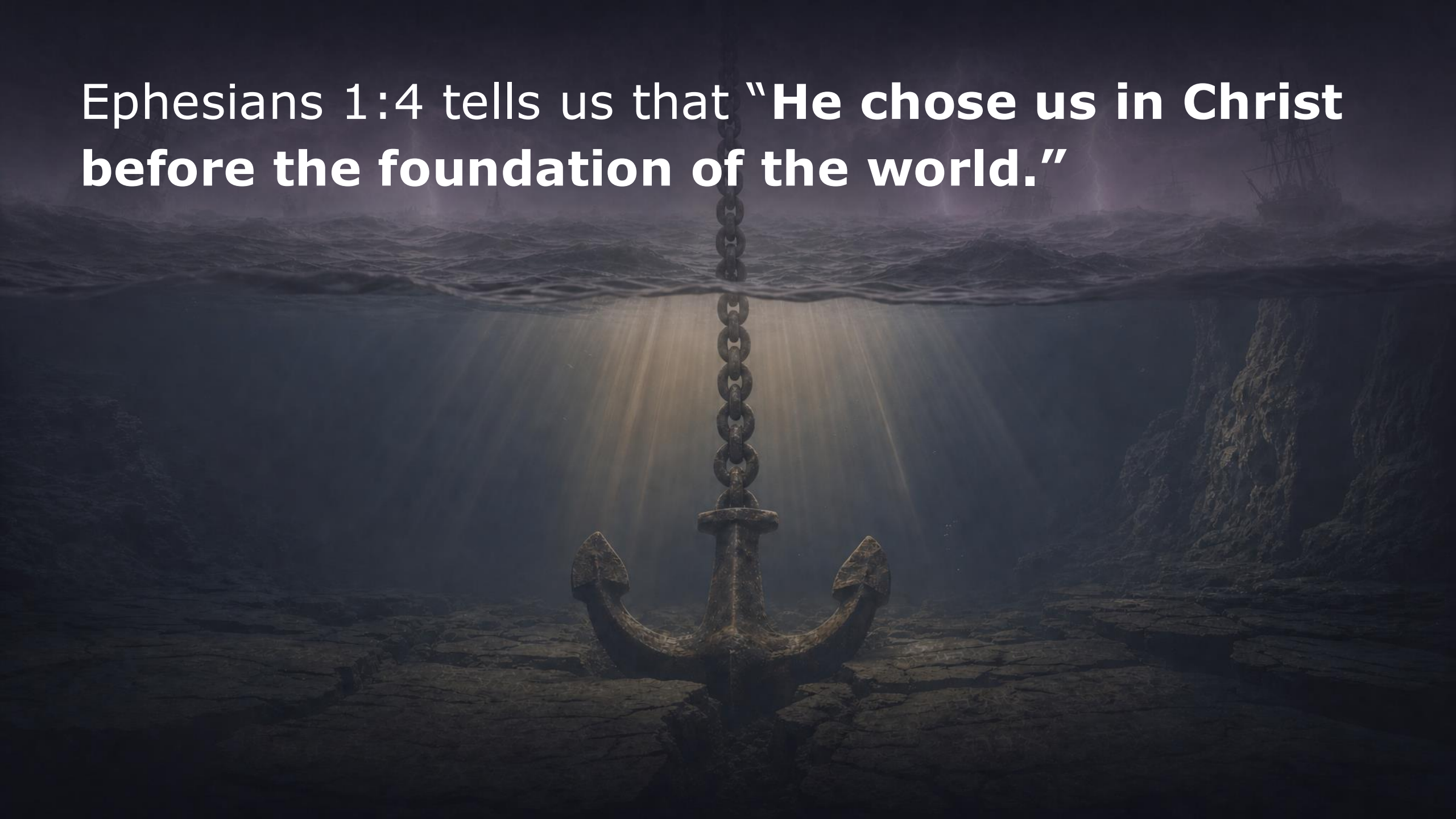

5. The Story Is About Him, Not Us—But We Have Always Been on His Mind.



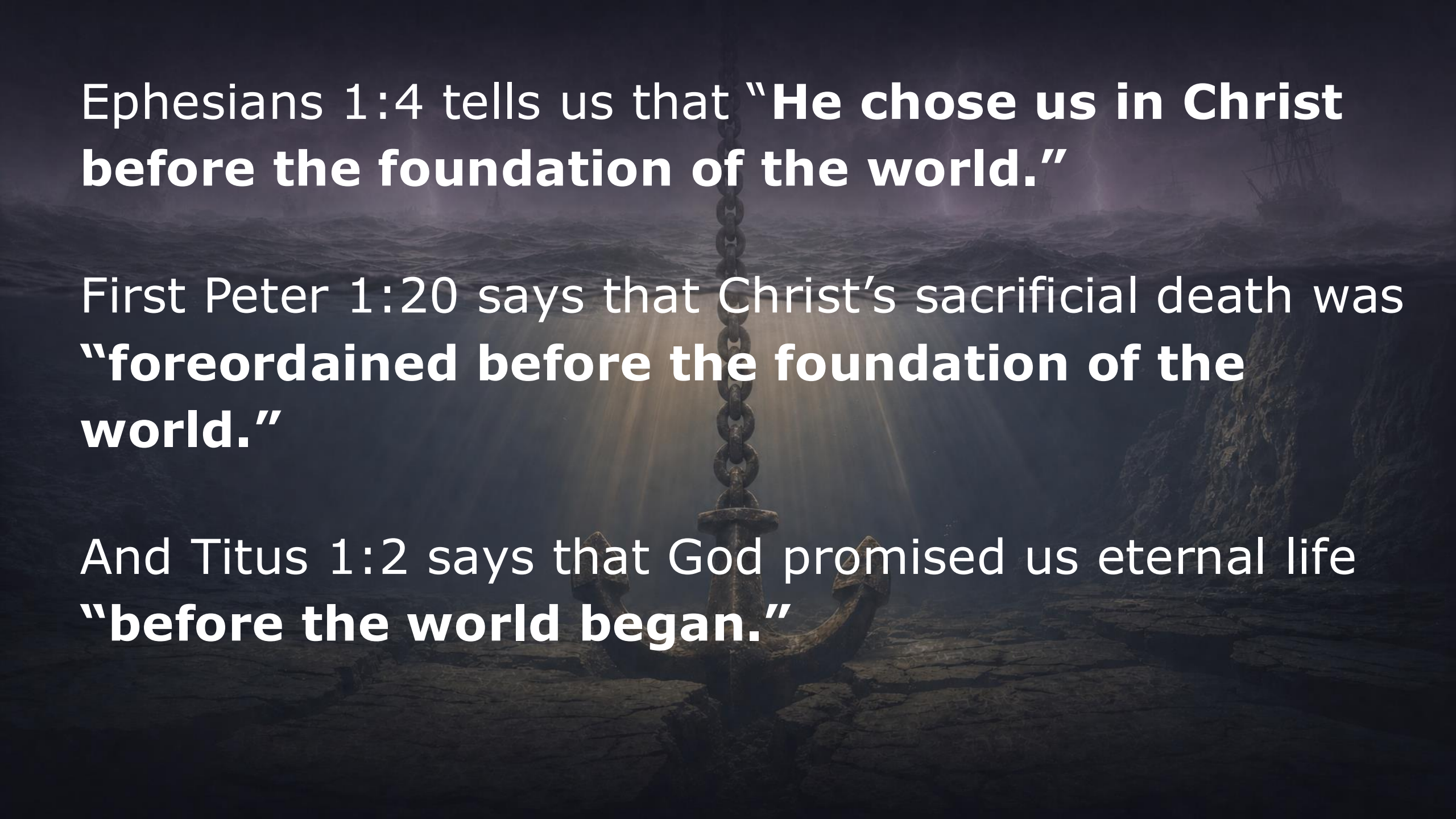
Ephesians 1:4 tells us that **“He chose us in Christ before the foundation of the world.”**
