Does it have healthy self-sustaining churches that can continue multiply and spread the Gospel within their own communities?






The Joshua Project defines Unreached People Groups (UPGs) as communities with less than 2% Evangelical Christian adherents, and little to no access to the Gospel.








An Unengaged Unreached People Group (UUPG) is an unreached people group with no known active church planting or missionary activity underway.




