Week 7: Stay on Target

[14] Remind them of these things, and charge them before God not to quarrel about words, which does no good, but only ruins the hearers. [15] Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly handling the word of truth. [16] But avoid irreverent babble, for it will lead people into more and more ungodliness,

[17] and their talk will spread like gangrene. Among them are Hymenaeus and Philetus, [18] who have swerved from the truth, saying that the resurrection has already happened. They are upsetting the faith of some. [19] But God's firm foundation stands, bearing this seal: "The Lord knows those who are his," and, "Let everyone who names the name of the Lord depart from iniquity."

Threat: False Teaching

Pay careful attention to yourselves and to all the flock, in which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to care for the church of God, which he obtained with his own blood. I know that after my departure fierce wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; and from among your own selves will arise men speaking twisted things, to draw away the disciples after them. (Acts 20:28-30 ESV)

Threat: False Teaching

As I urged you when I was going to Macedonia, remain at Ephesus so that you may charge certain persons not to teach any different doctrine, nor to devote themselves to myths and endless genealogies, which promote speculations rather than the stewardship from God that is by faith.

(1 Timothy 1:3-4 ESV)

Threat: False Teaching

If anyone teaches a different doctrine and does not agree with the sound words of our Lord Jesus Christ and the teaching that accords with godliness, he is puffed up with conceit and understands nothing. He has an unhealthy craving for controversy and for quarrels about words, which produce envy, dissension, slander, evil suspicions, and constant friction among people who are depraved in mind and deprived of the truth, imagining that godliness is a means of gain. (1 Timothy 6:3-5 ESV)

How should Timothy deal with the present threat of false teaching?

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Avoid Quarrels

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Avoid Quarrels

- 1. Remind them of "these things:" Don't tire of teaching the foundational truths of the gospel (2:8-13)
- 2. Charge them before God: Warn people that their words either promote truth or undermine truth & this is serious in God's eyes.

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Fruit of False Teaching

- 1. Does no good ~ it's useless; has not redemptive, eternal value
- 2. Only ruins hearers ~ can cause emotional, mental, or spiritual wreckage ("ruin" in Greek: katastrophe)
- 3. Promotes ungodliness ~ godless chatter leads to godless living

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Fruit of False Teaching

4. Spreads like gangrene ~ false teaching is like a contagious disease

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Fruit of False Teaching

- 4. Spreads like gangrene ~ false teaching is like a contagious disease
- 5. Disrupt people's faith ~ words of truth promote faith (Rom. 10:17), but falsehood "flips the table" on people's faith ("upset" same word to describe Jesus flipping tables in the temple in John 2).

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1 Corinthians 15:12-14

Now if Christ is proclaimed as raised from the dead, how can some of you say that there is no resurrection of the dead? But if there is no resurrection of the dead, then not even Christ has been raised. And if Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain and your faith is in vain.

Hold Fast to God's Word

What does it mean to hold fast to God's Word?

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1. Study the truth diligently ~ spoudazo ~ "to make haste, be earnest, be zealous, make every effort"

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- 2. Handle the truth accurately ~ orthotomeo ~ "to cut a straight path" (contrast: those who "swerve from the truth").

"As a result of what he does, that is, how he teaches, others are bound to be affected, for better or for worse. If he cuts the road straight, people will be able to follow and so keep in the way. If, on the other hand, he misses the mark, the attention of the spectators will be distracted from the target and their eyes will follow the arrow however widely astray it has gone."

(Stott, BST: 2 Timothy, pg. 68-69)


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- 2. Handle the truth accurately ~ orthotomeo ~ "to cut a straight path" (contrast: those who "swerve from the truth").
