

"I will sing to the Lord, for he is highly exalted."


"The Lord is my strength and my defense, he is my salvation. He is my God, and I will praise him."

"The Lord is **my strength** and **my dense**, he is **my salvation** he is **my God**, and I will praise him." v.2



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The Lord is a warrior v.3




**"Who among the gods is like you, Lord?

In verses 1-21 the people are singing, "The Lord is my strength and my defense."


But when we get to v.24: they are saying, "What are we going to drink?"



The Tree of Healing (15:25–26)


Then Moses cried out to the Lord, and the Lord showed him a piece of wood. He threw it into the water, and the water became fit to drink.


