The Dow Jones Industrial Average fell more than 600 points Monday as anxiety over the health of technology behemoths sparked a broad retreat from the stock market.

The selling began in the technology sector, then morphed into a rout that dragged lower everything from oil conglomerates to manufacturing and entertainment firms.

It was the latest setback for the stock market, which has struggled to reach new highs since the S&P 500 suffered its worst month in more than seven years.

Apple Inc.'s 5% decline sparked the tech selloff after two of its suppliers cut its outlook, raising questions about demand for the company's iPhone line. Goldman Sachs Group Inc., meanwhile, took more than 100 points off the Dow industrials as concerns grew over the bank's interaction with a financier charged with stealing billions of dollars from the Malaysia Development Bhd. investment fund. And General Electric Co.

slumped below \$80 a share, the lowest price since March 2015, after comments from its chief executive failed to assuage worries about its future.

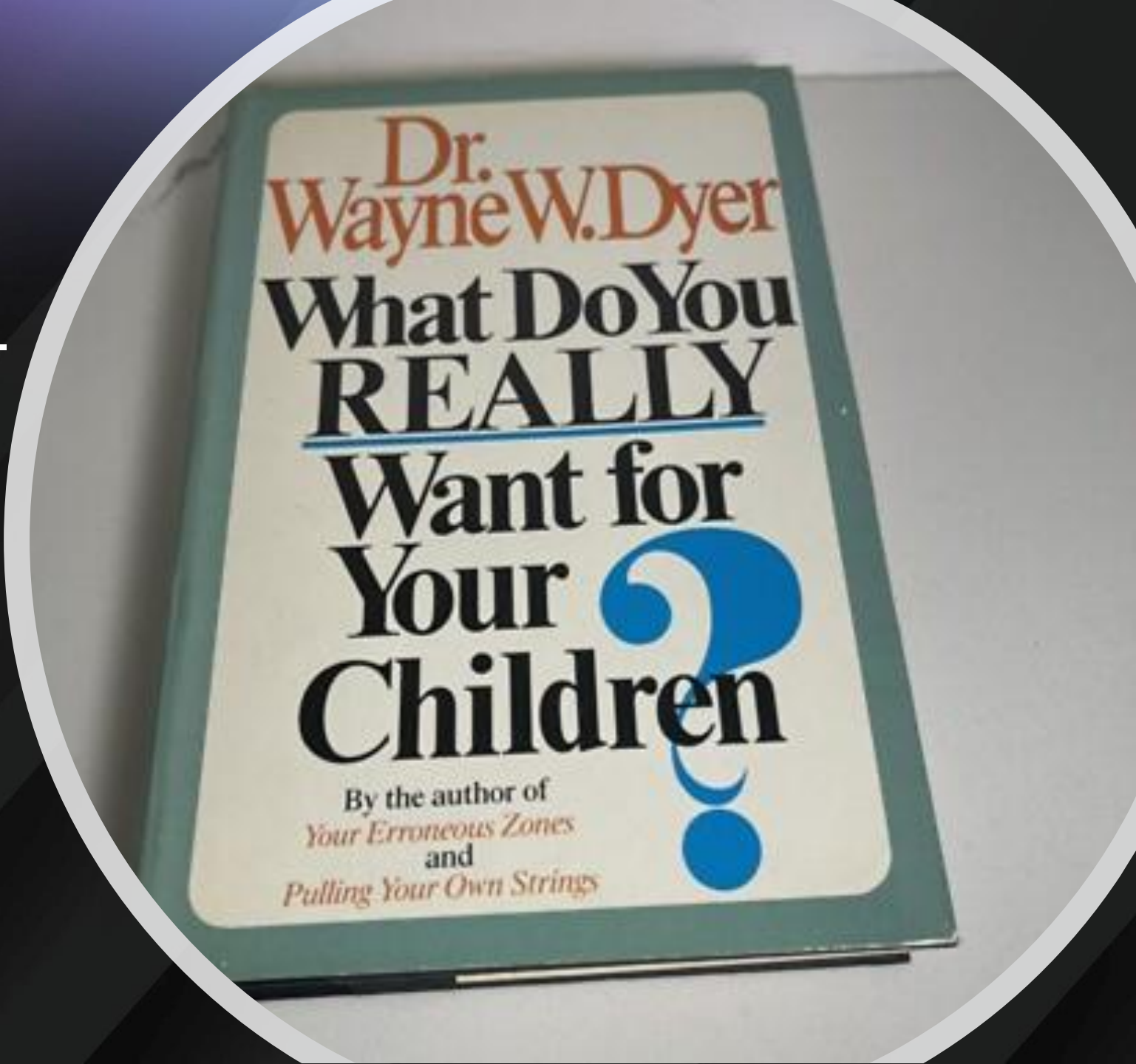


