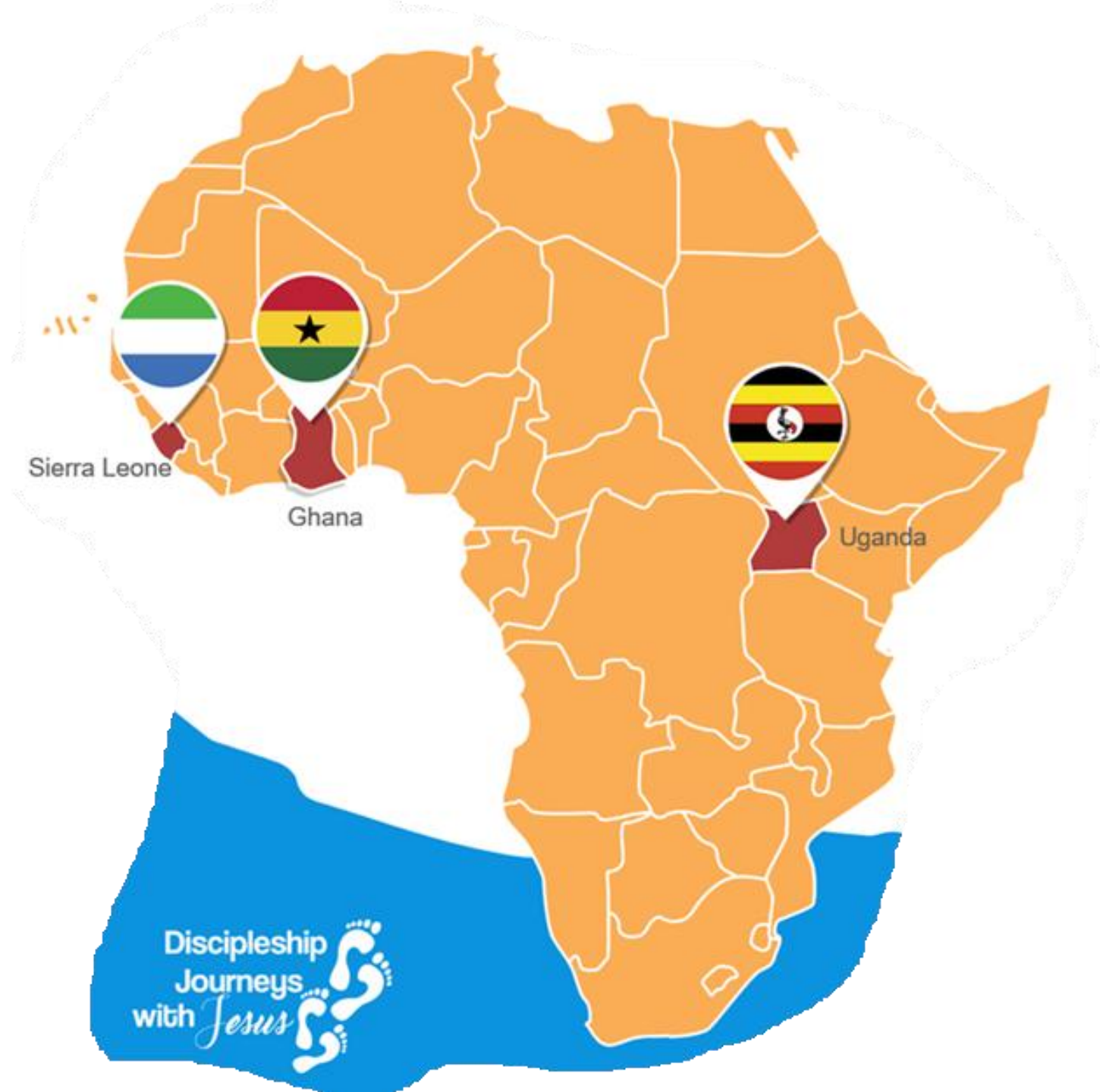
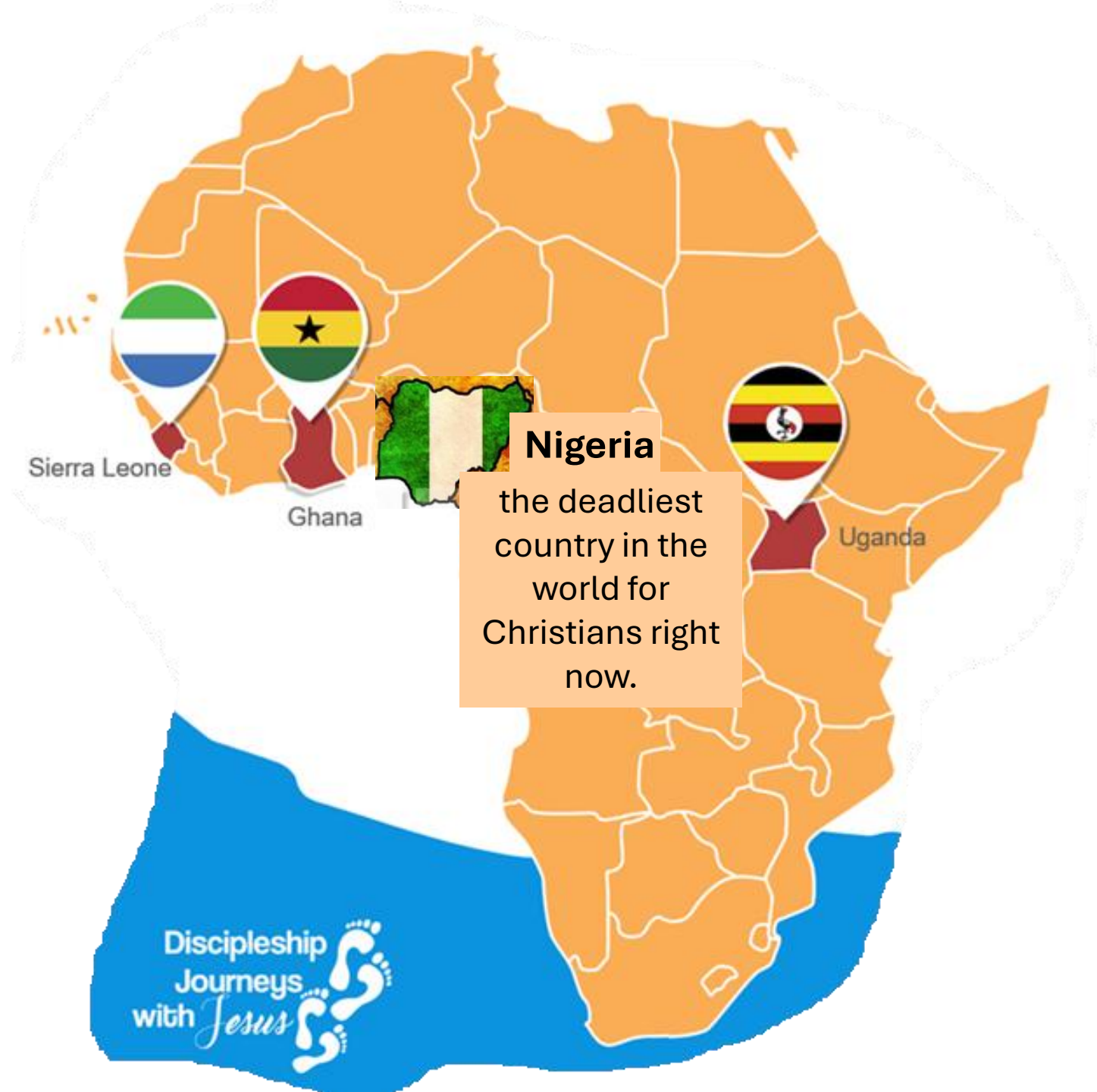

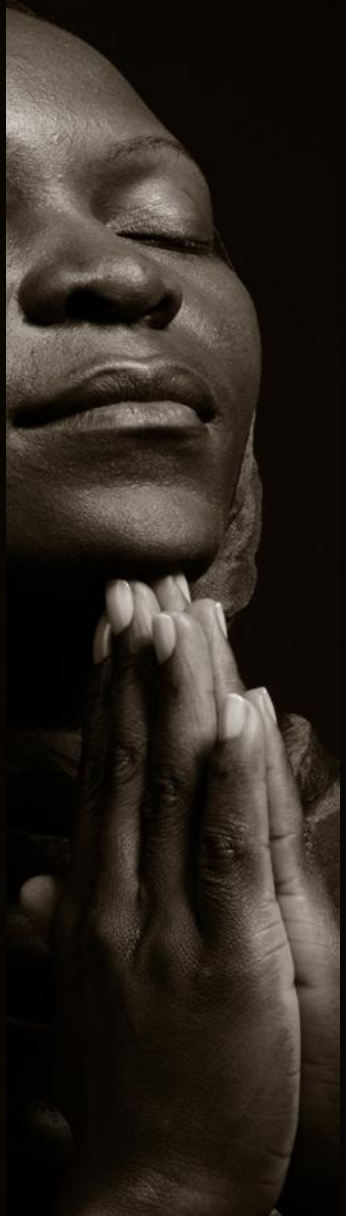
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Recent reports highlight the following alarming statistics and incidents from 2025:

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Over 125,000 Christians have been killed since 2010.



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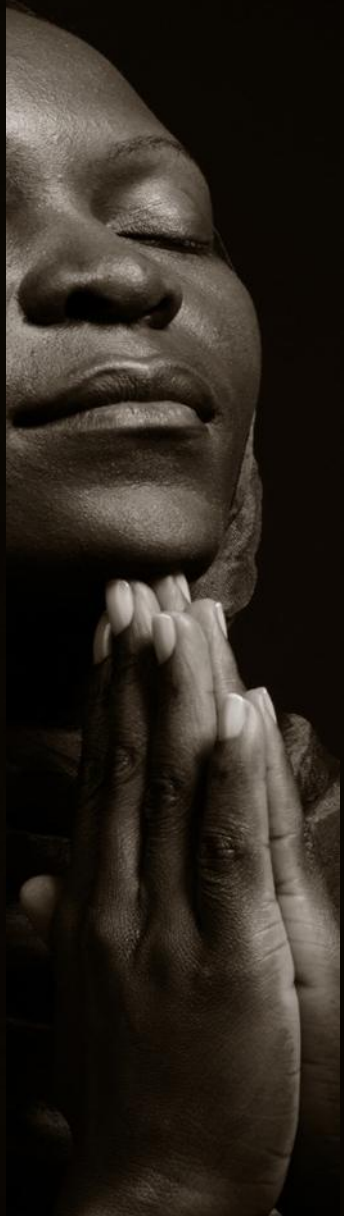
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Attacks on churches and communities:

Extremists have burned and destroyed thousands of churches and displaced millions of Christians.



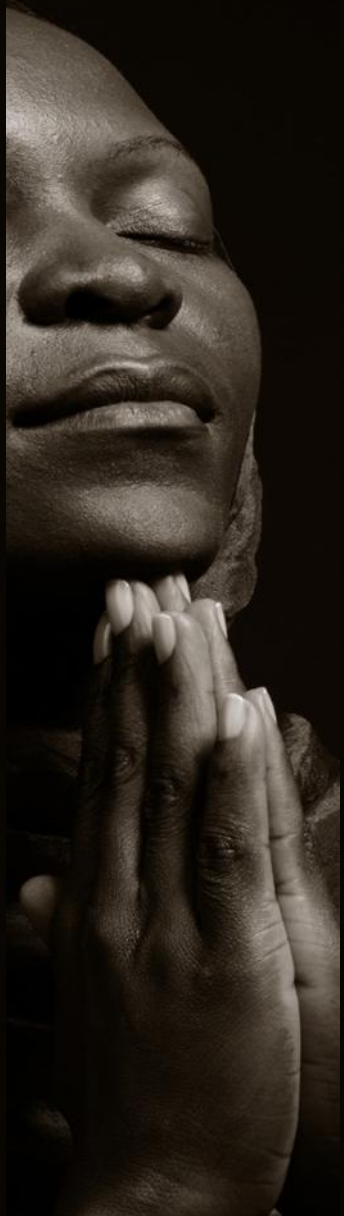

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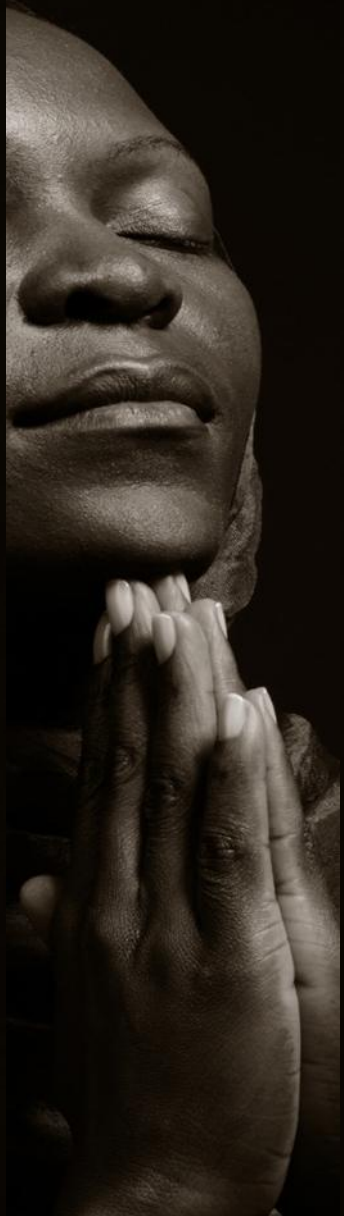


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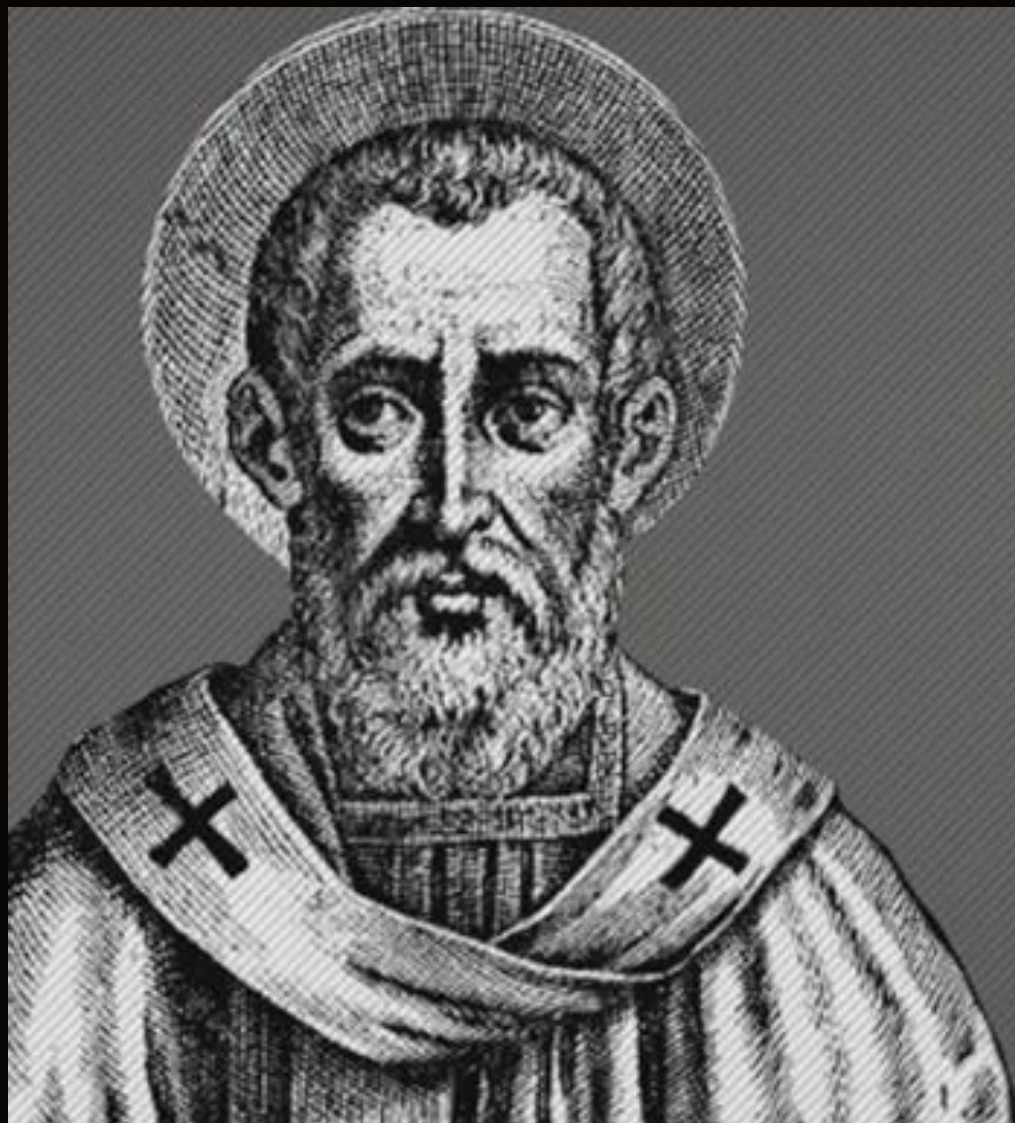
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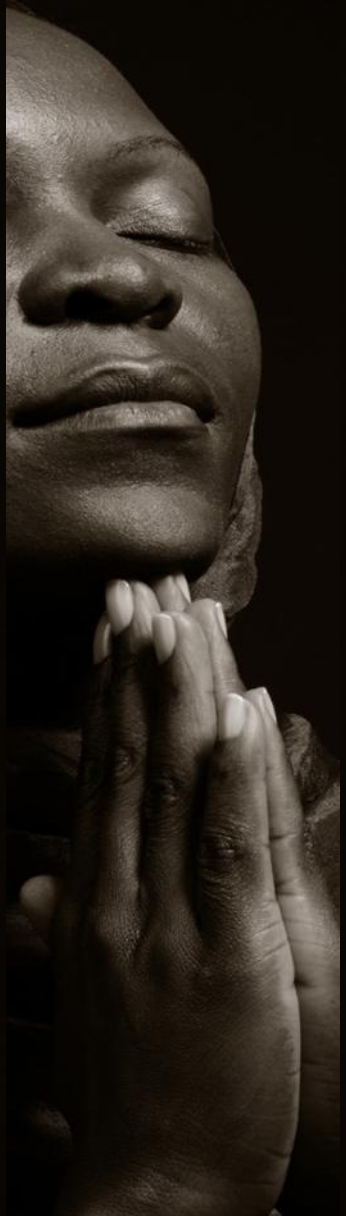
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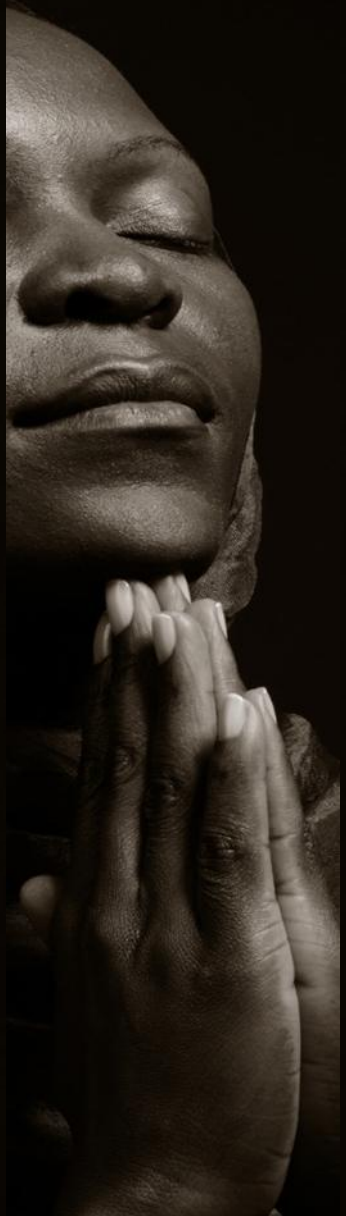
Prayer for Believers in Nigeria

1. That God would give them the right words to say to their captors and that they would fearlessly make Christ known.



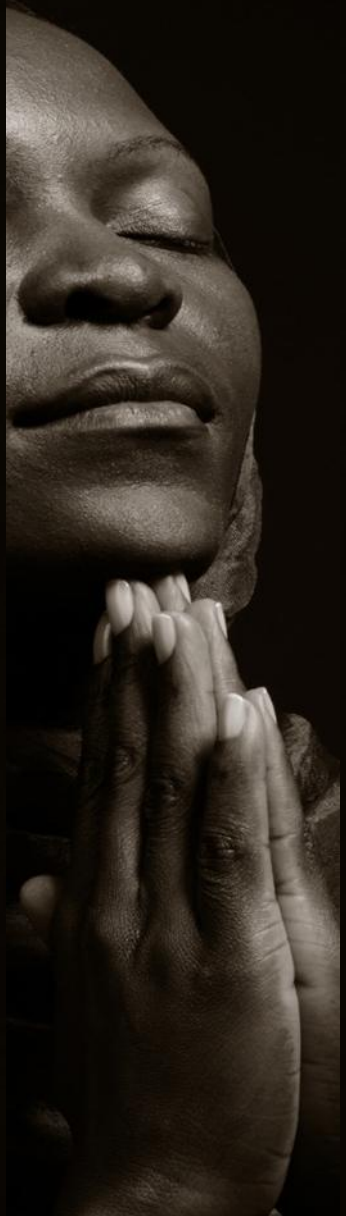
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
