



Coaching Tips

Matthew 28:19-20

Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, **teaching them to observe** all that I have commanded you...



James 1:22; 2:26

But **be doers of the word**, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves... For as the body apart from the spirit is dead, so also **faith apart from works is dead**.



Coaching Tips

Don't be lazy... Do honor the greatness of this calling by working hard.



Call to Discipleship

- Deny yourself, take up your cross daily, and follow wherever He leads (Lk. 9:23)
- Prioritize your relationship with Him over all other human relationships (Lk. 14:26)
- Follow him now and not when it is convenient (Matt. 8:22)



Call to Discipleship Follow him wherever he leads, even if its uncomfortable (Matt. 8:20) Be hated or persecuted by those who hate & persecute Christ (John 15:18-21)

2 Timothy 2:2-6

What you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses entrust to faithful men, who will be able to teach others also. Share in suffering as a good **soldier** of Christ Jesus...



2 Timothy 2:2-6

Coaching Tips

Don't pretend to be perfect... Do present an honest pursuit of following Jesus



Philippians 4:9

What you have learned and received and **heard and seen in me**—practice these things, and the God of peace will be with you.



Philippians 3:12-15 Not that I have already obtained this or am already perfect, but I press on to make it my own, because Christ Jesus has made me his own. Brothers, I do not consider that I have made it my own. But one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead...



Philippians 3:12-15 I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus. Let those of us who are mature think this way, and if in anything you think otherwise, God will reveal that also to you.



Coaching Tips

Don't forget we are in a spiritual battle... Do prioritize praying with & for each other.



1 Thessalonians 3:5 For this reason, when I could bear it no longer, I sent to learn about your faith, for fear that somehow the tempter had tempted you and our labor would be in vain.



2 Timothy 1:3 I thank God whom I serve, as did my ancestors, with a clear conscience, as I remember you constantly in my prayers night and day.



Coaching Tips

Don't try to do discipleship in your own strength... Do seek God's empowerment.



Colossians 1:28-29 Him we proclaim, warning everyone and teaching everyone with all wisdom, that we may present everyone mature in Christ. For this I toil, struggling with all his energy that he powerfully works within me.



Coaching Tips

Don't try to serve out of an empty cup... Do feed your soul by abiding in Christ & His Word.





Luke 5:15-16

But now even more the report about him went abroad, and great crowds gathered to hear him and to be healed of their infirmities. But he would withdraw to desolate places and pray.



John 15:4-5

Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me. I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing.
