

- [6] The lines have fallen for me in pleasant places; indeed, I have a beautiful inheritance.
- [7] I bless the LORD who gives me counsel; in the night also my heart instructs me.
- [8] I have set the LORD always before me; because he is at my right hand, I shall not be shaken.
