BIG IDEA

Redemption is not merely rescue from slavery – it is invitation into the presence and purpose of God.

Exodus 19:1-5

[1] On the third new moon after the people of Israel had gone out of the land of Egypt, on that day they came into the wilderness of Sinai. [2] They set out from Rephidim and came into the wilderness of Sinai, and they encamped in the wilderness. There Israel encamped before the mountain, [3] while Moses went up to God. The LORD called to him out of the mountain, saying,

Exodus 19:1-5

“Thus you shall say to the house of Jacob, and tell the people of Israel: [4] ‘You yourselves have seen what I did to the Egyptians, and how I bore you on eagles’ wings and brought you to myself. [5] Now therefore, if you will indeed obey my voice and keep my covenant, you shall be my treasured possession among all peoples, for all the earth is mine;

Exodus 19:1-5

Deuteronomy 32:10-12

[10] “He found him in a desert land, and in the howling waste of the wilderness; he encircled him, he cared for him, he kept him as the apple of his eye. [11] **Like an eagle** that stirs up its nest, that flutters over its young, spreading out its wings, catching them, bearing them on its pinions, [12] **the LORD alone guided him**, no foreign god was with him.

Deuteronomy 7:6-8

[6] “For you are a **people holy to the LORD your God. The LORD your God has chosen you to be a people for his treasured possession**, out of all the peoples who are on the face of the earth.

[7] It was *not because you were more in number* than any other people that the LORD set his love on you and chose you, for you were the fewest of all peoples,

Deuteronomy 7:6-8

[8] **but it is because the LORD loves you** and is keeping the oath that he swore to your fathers, that the LORD has brought you out with a mighty hand and redeemed you from the house of slavery, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt.

Titus 2:11-14

[11] For the **grace of God** has appeared, bringing salvation for all people, [12] training us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in the present age, [13] waiting for our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, [14] **who gave himself for us to redeem us** from all lawlessness and to purify for himself a **people for his own possession** who are zealous for good works.

Exodus 19:6-9

[9] But you are a chosen race, **a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession,** *that you may proclaim the excellencies of him* who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.

[10] Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

1 Peter 2:9-12

[11] Beloved, I urge you as sojourners and exiles to abstain from the passions of the flesh, which wage war against your soul. [12] Keep your conduct among the Gentiles honorable, ***so that*** when they speak against you as evildoers, ***they may see your good deeds and glorify God on the day of visitation.***

[10] the LORD said to Moses, “Go to the people and consecrate them today and tomorrow, and let them wash their garments [11] and be ready for the third day. For on the third day the LORD will come down on Mount Sinai in the sight of all the people. [12] And you shall set limits for the people all around, saying, ‘Take care not to go up into the mountain or touch the edge of it. Whoever touches the mountain shall be put to death

Exodus 19:16-20

[16] On the morning of the third day there were thunders and lightnings and a thick cloud on the mountain and a very loud trumpet blast, so that all the people in the camp trembled. [17] Then Moses brought the people out of the camp to meet God, and they took their stand at the foot of the mountain.

Exodus 19:16-20

[18] Now Mount Sinai was wrapped in smoke because the LORD had descended on it in fire. The smoke of it went up like the smoke of a kiln, and the whole mountain trembled greatly. [19] And as the sound of the trumpet grew louder and louder, Moses spoke, and God answered him in thunder. [20] The LORD came down on Mount Sinai, to the top of the mountain. And the LORD called Moses to the top of the mountain, and Moses went up.

Revelation 4:5-8

[5] From the throne came flashes of **lightning**, and rumblings and peals of **thunder**, and before the throne were burning seven torches of **fire**, which are the seven spirits of God... [8] And the four living creatures, each of them with six wings, are full of eyes all around and within, and day and night they never cease to say, "**Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord God Almighty**, who was and is and is to come!"

Hebrews 10:19-22

[19] Therefore, brothers, since **we have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus**, [20] by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain, that is, through his flesh, [21] and since we have a great priest over the house of God, [22] **let us draw near** with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.
