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
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
2. Faith Embraces a Divine Identity and Destiny (vv.24-26)

He regarded disgrace for the sake of Christ as of greater value than the treasures of Egypt, because he was looking ahead to his reward.

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
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They taught him who he is (v24)

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3. Faith Eyes the Eternal Prize (v.26)

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
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
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4. Faith Appropriates God's Salvation (v.28)
