The Four Choices of Faith

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"Moses, when he was born was "beautiful in God's sight." (Acts 7:20)

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27 By faith he left Egypt, not fearing the king's anger; he endured because **he saw him who is invisible.**

2. Faith Embraces a Divine Identity and Destiny (vv.24-26)

²⁴ By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be known as the son of Pharaoh's daughter. ²⁵ He chose to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the fleeting pleasures of sin. He regarded disgrace for the sake of Christ as of greater value than the treasures of Egypt, because he was looking ahead to his reward.

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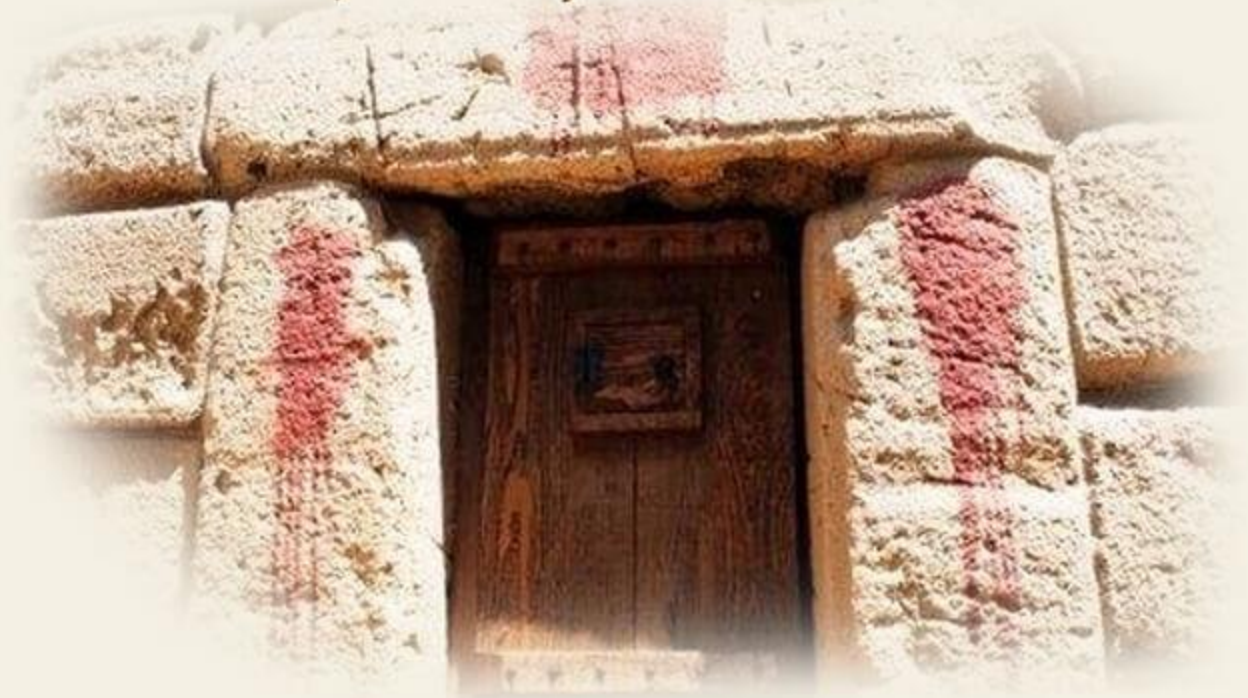
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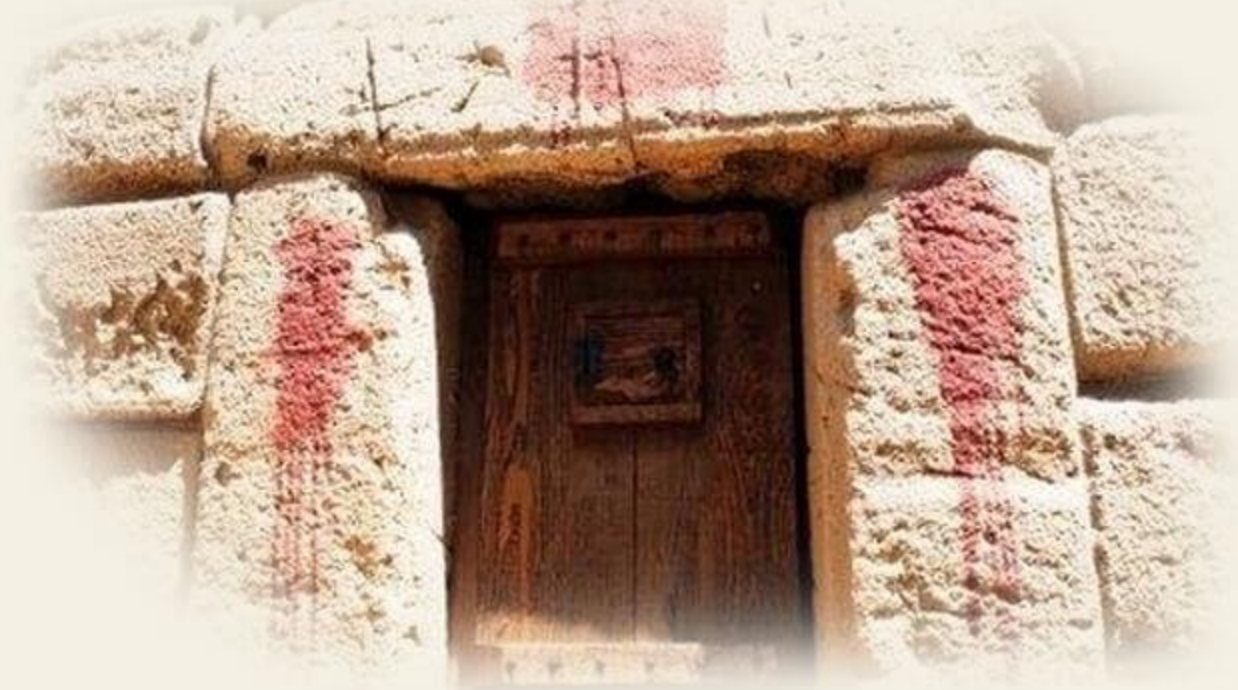
4. Faith Appropriates God's Salvation (v.28)
