




Matthew 5:27-28 ²⁷ "You have heard that it was said, 'You shall not commit adultery.' 28 But I tell you that anyone who looks at a woman lustfully has already committed adultery with her in his heart.

One could translation v28 to read; "everyone who looks at a woman with the purpose of desiring her..."

Martin Luther Quipped;

"You cannot prevent birds from flying over-head, but you can prevent them from building a nest in your hair."





Shannon changes v.28 to read: "But I say to you any woman who envisions a man longingly has already committed adultery in her heart."

What remedy is there against the temptation both man and women face? Jesus adds verses 29-30.

²⁹ If your right eye causes you to stumble, gouge it out and throw it away. It is better for you to lose one part of your body than for your whole body to be thrown into hell. 30 And if your right hand causes you to stumble, cut it off and throw it away. It is better for you to lose one part of your body than for your whole body to go into hell.

Job 31:1,7-8:

1"I made a covenant with my eyes not to look lustfully at a girl... 7 if my steps (feet) have turned from the path, if my heart has been led by my eyes, or if my hands have been defiled... 8 then may others eat what I have sown, and may my crops be uprooted.
