1. The Sacred Copy: Obedience in the Repetition (36:8–38:20)

“All those who were skilled among the workers made the tabernacle with ten curtains of finely twisted linen and blue, purple and scarlet yarn, with cherubim woven into them by expert hands.” (Exodus 36:8)

2. The Foundation of Redemption: The Census Silver (38:21–28)

“Then the Lord said to Moses, when you take a census of the Israelites to count them, each one must pay the Lord a ransom for his life at the time he is counted.” (Exodus 30:11)

**“The silver obtained from those of the community who were counted in the census was 100 talents and 1,775 shekels... The 100 talents of silver were used to cast the bases for the sanctuary and for the curtain.”
(Exodus 38:25, 27)**

3. The Bronze and the Books: Judgment, Cleansing, and Accountability (38:1–8, 21–31)

"They built the altar of burnt offering... and overlaid the altar with bronze." (Exodus 38:1–2)

These are the amounts of the materials used for the tabernacle... The total amount of the gold... was 29 talents... the silver... 100 talents... the bronze... 70 talents." (Exodus 38:21, 24, 29)



God Keeps the Books — What Will Survive the Fire?



**And Moses saw all the work, and behold, they had done it; as the Lord had commanded, so had they done it. Then Moses blessed them.”
(Exodus 39:43)**

First, stop improvising your spiritual life — obey the specifics of Scripture even when they are inconvenient.

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Second, rest on the silver — your standing with God was never your achievement; it is the equal ransom paid by Christ's blood, and it is exactly the same for you as it is for anyone else in this room.

Third, pass through the bronze — start with the altar of repentance, not the stage of performance.

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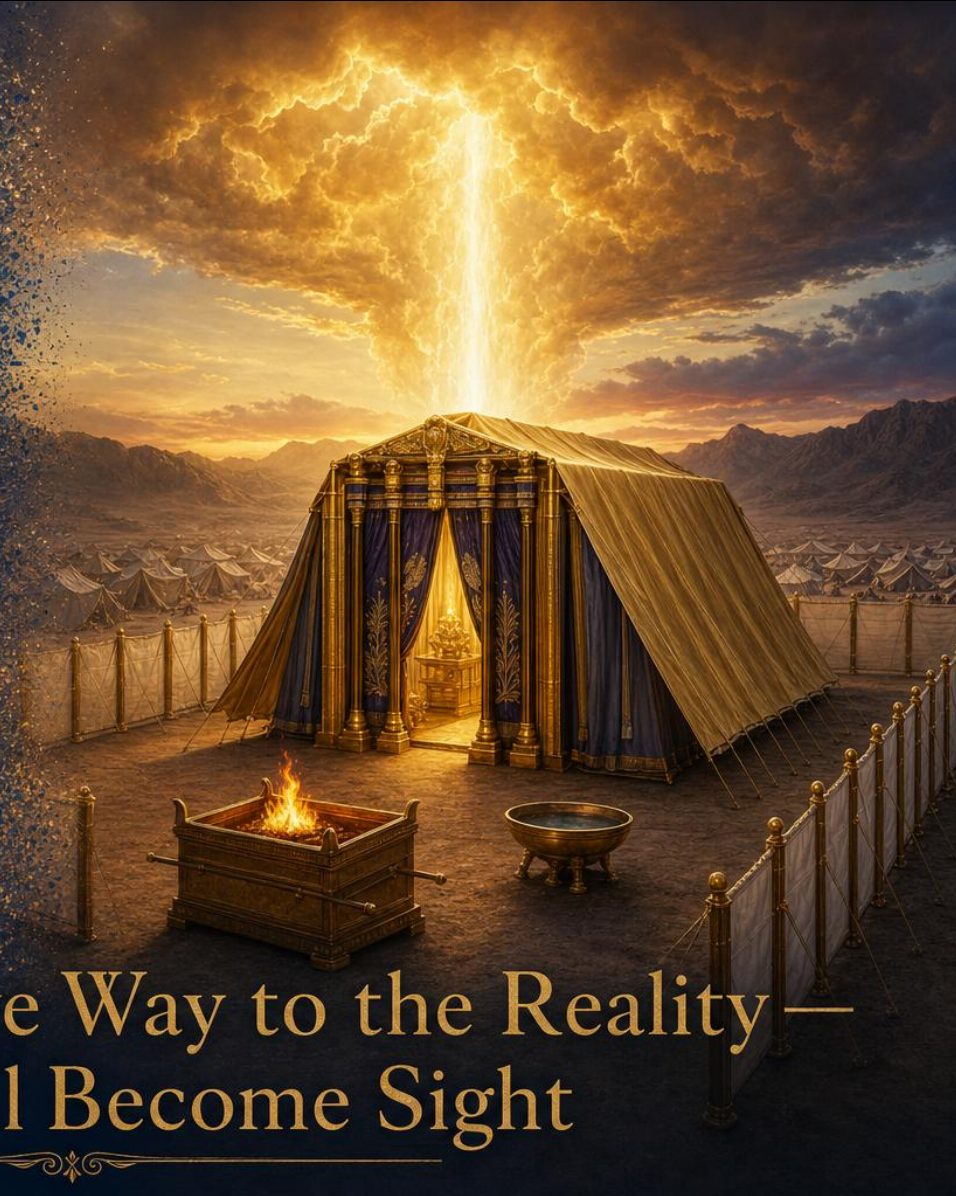
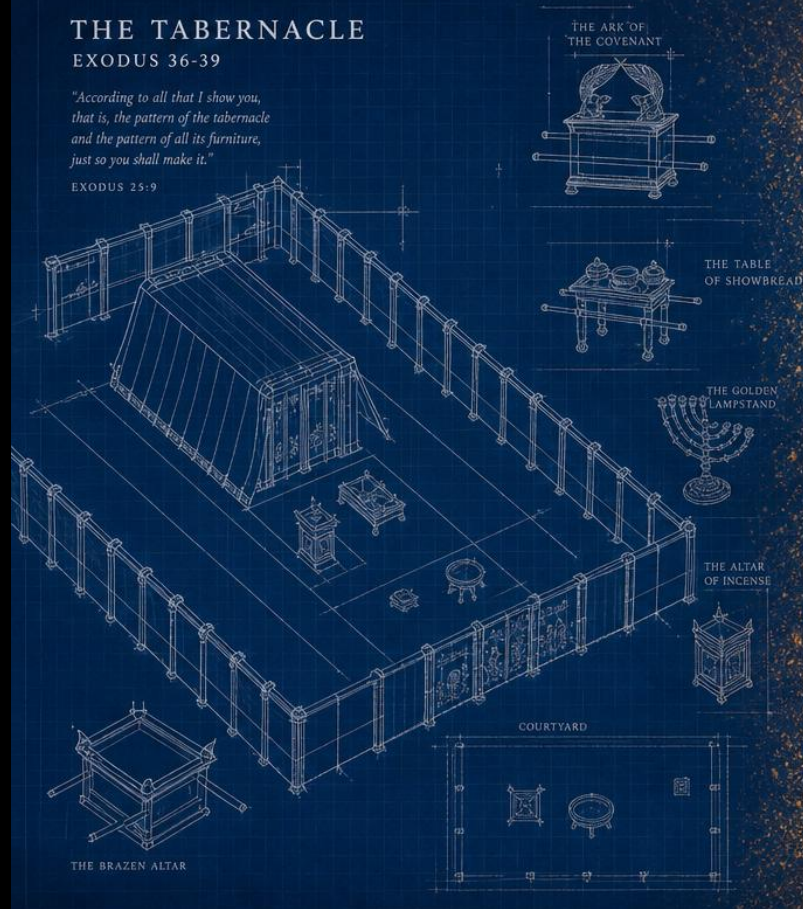
Fourth, watch your inventory — spend your life on what will actually survive the **final audit**.
