John 11:1-4 "This sickness will not end in death. No, it is for God's glory so that God's Son may be glorified through it."

How was Jesus, God the Son, glorified through the Lazarus story? How about MY story?
John 11:5-10 "Jesus loved Martha, her sister and Lazarus. So when he heard that Lazarus was sick, He stayed where He was two more days" • If indeed Jesus greatly loved them, should He not have rushed to help them? Why delay?
What is required of us to TRUST God's larger, better plan when we are disappointed in God?
John 11:11-16 "Our friend Lazarusis dead, and for your sake I am glad I was not there, so that you may believe" • So they may believe what?
John 11:17-21 "Lazarus had already been in the tomb for four days 'Lord, if You had been here my brother would not have died!"
• How do we handle life's disappointments when God doesn't meet our expectations or hopes?
How do we handle other people holding us responsible for God disappointing them?
John 11:22-26 "I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in Me will live, even though they die; and whoever lives by believing in Me will never die. Do you believe this?" • What does it mean??
John 11:27-38 "Yes, Lord, I believe that You are the Messiah, the Son of God, who is to come into the world." "Jesus wept."
• First it was Simon Peter at Caesarea Philippi, now it is Martha at Bethany! Is it my belief too?
Why did Jesus weep?
John 11:38-44 "FatherI said this for the benefit of the people standing here, that they would believe that You sent Me." "Lazarus, come out!" • Why is it important to the Gospel that Jesus came to earth, SENT by God the Father?
What does the resurrection of Lazarus prove about Jesus?
Why did Jesus not save Himself from death on the cross by His same Lazarus raising power?

3/09/25 Matthew 16:13-20

- Caesarea Philippi and Jesus' question: "Who do people say the Son of Man is?"
- Peter's response: "You are the Christ (Messiah). The Son of the living God!"
- Jesus' declaration: "Upon this rock (petra) I will build My Church and the gates of Hades will not prevail against it." Jesus' declaration it is the TRUTH of His identity that forms the basis of the Gospel & the foundation of Jesus building HIS 'Church'.

3/16/23 Matthew 16:21-28

- Jesus' first prediction of His Jerusalem suffering at the hands of Religious & Civic leaders / His death & resurrection!
- Peter's rebuke of Jesus & Jesus' counter challenge of Peter
- Jesus' explanation of what is required for someone to be HIS disciple in real life

3/23/25 Matthew 17:1-13

- The Transfiguration of Jesus! Appearance of Moses & Elijah in 'heavenly bodies'.
- The entire experience being a partial fulfillment of Matthew 16:28.
- God's voice from heaven confirming Jesus is the Son of God...Listen to Him!
- Jesus' second prediction of His resurrection
- Jesus' declaration that John the Baptist is the fulfillment of the closing prophecy of the Old Testament (Malachi 4:5,6)

3/30/25 Mark 9:14-29 (Matthew 17:14-19)

- Demonstration of the demonic spirit oppression of a young man over a long period
- Jesus' deliverance of that young man from the dark kingdom stronghold on him
- Jesus' prioritization of FAITH if participation with God in miracles
- Proof of Jesus' authority & power over Satan's dark kingdom of opposition to God

4/06/25 John 11

- Jesus' intentional delay in love, when He heard of Lazarus illness, for God's glory?!
- Jesus' famous statement 'I am the resurrection and the life..."!
- Jesus' wept and then Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead proving His power over death
- Jewish leaders determined to eliminate Jesus, strategize a plan!
- Jesus' departure to a remote place to make final preparations for Passover/Easter
