Joshua 18:10 "Joshua cast lots for them in Shiloh in the presence of the LORD, and there he distributed the land to the Israelites according to their tribes..."

• 500 years later The Abrahamic Land Covenant finally fulfilled. (Genesis 15:18-21)  Why did it take so long for Israelites to receive their inheritance?
Joshua 21:43-45 "So the LORD gave Israel all the land HE had sworn to give their ancestors, and they took possession of it and settled there. The LORD gave them rest on every side, just as He had sworn to their ancestors None of all the LORD's good promises to Israel failed; every one was fulfilled."
