

1. God's Deliverance from Egypt . . . WHAT were God's objectives?

a. Exodus 3:7-10

- i. To demonstrate God's uniqueness & supremacy to His people and the world...then and since!
- ii. To deliver His Israelite slaves from Egyptian bondage and bring them back to His Covenant Land promised to Abraham, Isaac & Jacob.

b. 10 Plagues, each humiliating one of Egypt's "gods" (Exodus 7-11) Exodus 12:12 *"I will bring judgment on all the gods of Egypt. I am the LORD."*

c. Exodus 7:5 *"The EGYPTIANS will know I am the LORD when I stretch out My hand against Egypt and bring the Israelites out of it."*

d. Exodus 8:19 *"The MAGICIANS said to Pharaoh, 'This is the finger of God...'"*

e. Exodus 14:4 *"I will gain glory through Pharaoh and all his army, and the Egyptians will know that I am the LORD."*

f. Exodus 14:31 *"When the Israelites saw the mighty hand of the LORD displayed against the Egyptians, the people feared the LORD and put their trust in HIM, and in Moses His servant."*
