5 My soul will be satisfied as with fat and rich food, and my mouth will praise you with joyful lips,

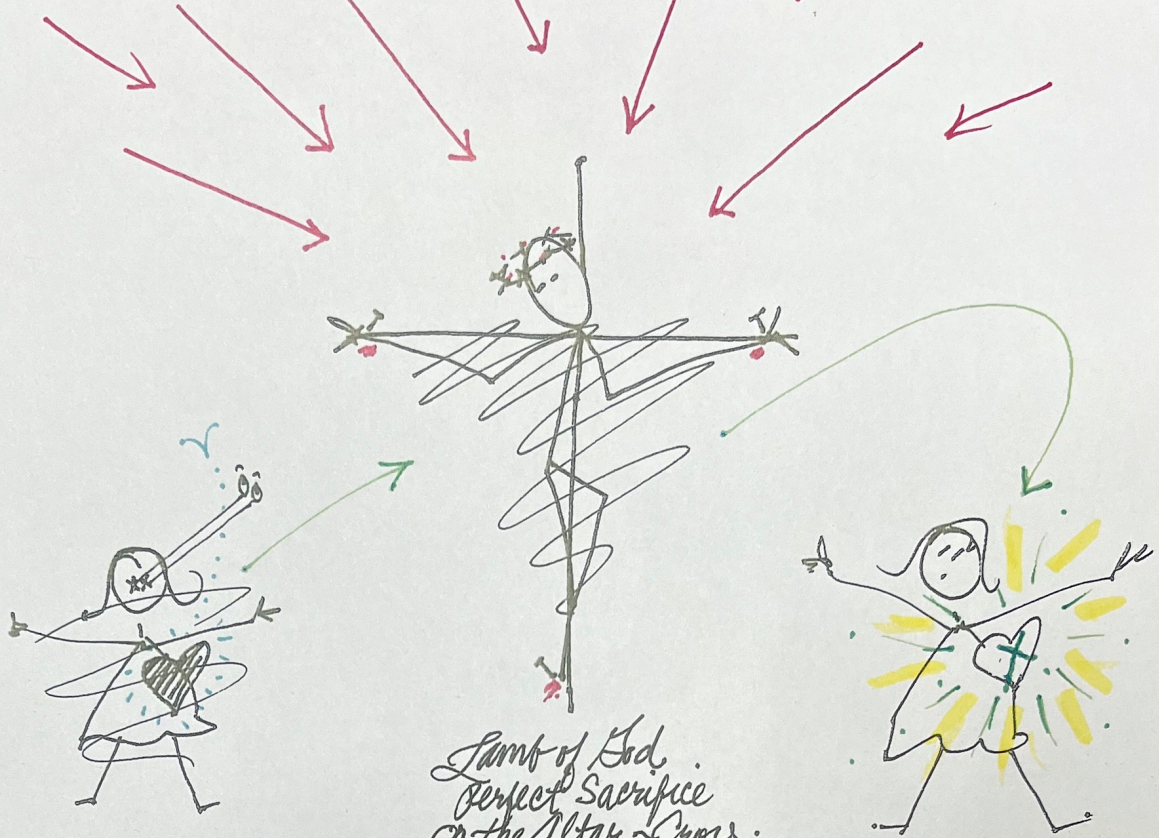
6 when I remember you upon my bed, and meditate on you in the watches of the night;

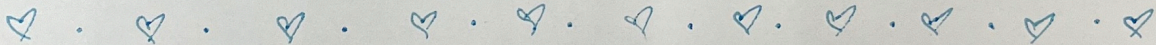

Love

Believe in His love, rest in His love, and praise Him!

“I praise you, Lord, because your steadfast love is better than life, may my lips praise you. Grant me the grace to bless you every day, as long as I live; in your name lift up my hands.”

Behold

Behold, bow, and believe in His power and glory.

“Lord, I have looked upon you in the sanctuary, beholding your power and glory.”

Savor

Savor God and His Word. Marinate your mind and heart in who He is and in His promises.

“My soul will be satisfied as with fat and rich food, and my mouth will praise you with joyful lips, when I remember you upon my bed, and meditate on you in the watches of the night.”

Sing

You are in the shadow of His wings of His mercy!

“You have been my help, and in the shadow of your wings I will sing for joy.

Cling

Cling to the Lord and rely on His mighty righteous right hand.

O Lord, my soul clings to you; your right hand upholds me.
