Matthew 5v16 (CSB)

9. The practice of generosity reveals your heart's true intentions.

11. Jesus' invitation to all disciples is to give with the right heart.

Matthew 6v3-4 (CSB)

13. We are called not give self-consciously, but unself-consciously.

14. The motivation and intention of your giving is what matters to Jesus.

15. The heart's three motivations when giving:

- Seek the praise of others
- Preserve our anonymity but secretly "pat ourselves on the back"
- We desire only the approval of our Father
