Generosity Journey

- 1 Initial**
I am giving for the first time, learning to **TRUST GOD** with the resources he has entrusted to me in this life.
- 2 INTENTIONAL**
I am choosing an amount (or %) to give and making it **RECURRING** at least 1x a month.
- 3 PRIORITY**
I am putting **GOD FIRST** (usually a **tithe = 10%**), giving generously and in a way that impacts my lifestyle.
- 4 FEARLESS**
I am depending on **GOD'S PROVISION**, asking not "How much should I give?" but "How little should I keep?"
- 5 LEGACY**
I am impacting the future of God's kingdom, giving to **OUTLAST MY LIFE**.
