- 5. Therefore, you should pray like this: "Our Father in heaven,"
- 6. "your name be honored as holy."
- 7. "Your kingdom come."
- 8. "Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven."

- 12. Test = a decision or moment of refinement Temptation = a lure toward sin and unfaithfulness
- 13. God's tests aim to build trust and faithfulness, while the evil one twists those tests into temptations to destroy or deceive.

- 15. The Lord's Prayer invites us to intimacy over formality.
