

Satan- A Fallen Star

Revelation 9:1

Revelation 9:1: Then the fifth angel sounded: And I saw a star fallen from heaven to the earth. To him was given the key to the bottomless pit.

2 Corinthians 2:11: ...lest Satan should take advantage of us; for we are not ignorant of his devices.

Luke 10:18: I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven.

Ezekiel 28:12-15: Thus says the Lord God: "You were the seal of perfection, full of wisdom and perfect in beauty. You were in Eden, the garden of God; Every precious stone was your covering: The sardius, topaz, and diamond, beryl, onyx, and jasper, sapphire, turquoise, and emerald with gold. The workmanship of your timbrels and pipes was prepared for you on the day you were created (1x). You were the anointed cherub who covers; I established you; You were on the holy mountain of God; You walked back and forth in the midst of fiery stones. You were perfect in your ways from the day you were created (2x), till iniquity was found in you."

God is Eternal, Omnipotent, Omniscient, Omnipresent.

Colossians 1:16: All things were created through Him and for Him!

Isaiah 14:12-15: How you are fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! How you are cut down to the ground, You who weakened the nations! For you have said in your heart: I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God; I will also sit on the mount of the congregation on the farthest sides of the north; I will ascend above the heights of the clouds, I will be like the Most High. Yet you shall be brought down to Sheol, to the lowest depths of the Pit.

1 Timothy 3:6: ...not a novice, lest being puffed up with pride he fall into the same condemnation as the devil.

In Revelation 12:4: we learn that when Satan fell from heaven, he drew a third of the stars (angels) with him!

The Bible refers to these fallen angels as angels who sinned, demons, evil spirits, unclean spirits, principalities and powers, rulers of darkness, spiritual hosts of wickedness!

Revelation 9:1: Then the fifth angel sounded: And I saw a star fallen from heaven to the earth. To him was given the key to the bottomless pit.

Revelation 9:11: And they had as king over them the angel of the bottomless pit, whose name in Hebrew is Abaddon, but in Greek he has the name Apollyon. (Destroyer!)

- Lucifer (Isaiah 14:12)
- He exalted himself as king of the angels (Isaiah 14:13)



- A fallen angel (Luke 10:18, Isaiah 14:12, Revelation 9:1)
- Abaddon and Apollyon (Destroyer) (Revelation 9:11)

Revelation 12:9-10: So the great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old, called the Devil 34x- (accuser) and Satan 54x- (enemy), who deceives the whole world; the accuser of our brethren who accused them before God day and night.

- Tempter (Matthew 4:3)
- Speaks of his constant endeavor to entice man to sin!

Luke 4:13: When the devil had ended every temptation, he departed from Him until an opportune time.

- Beelzebub (Ruler of the demons) (Matthew 12:27)
- Father of lies (John 8:44)
- (What's the TRUTH?)
- Murderer (John 8:44)
- Thief (steal, kill, destroy) (John 10:10)
- Evil one (John 17:15)
- Wicked one... whole world under sway (1 John 5:19)
- Ruler of this world (John 12:31, 14:30)
- God of this age ... who blinds (2 Corinthians 4:4)
- Hinderer (1 Thessalonians 2:18)
- Opposes (Zechariah 3:1)

- Afflicts (Job 2:7)

Satan may attack but **NOT** possess us as Christians!

Ephesians 6:11-12: Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places.

Ephesians 6:16: ...fiery darts of the wicked one.

The Christian life is a battleground, not a playground! ~ C.S. Lewis

1 Peter 5:8: Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.

2 Corinthians 11:3: But I fear, lest somehow, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness (trickery), so your minds may be corrupted (spoil, ruin, defile) from the simplicity that is in Christ.

2 Timothy 2:25-26: ...in humility correcting those who are in opposition, if God perhaps will grant them repentance, so that they may know the truth, and that they may come to their senses and escape the snare of the devil, having been taken captive by him to do his will.

Luke 22:31-32: Simon, Simon! Indeed, Satan has asked for you, that he may sift you as wheat. But I have prayed for you, that your faith should not fail; and when you have returned to Me, strengthen your brethren.

John 1:12-13: But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

1 John 4:4: You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.

1 John 2:14: I have written to you, young men, because you are strong, and the word of God abides in you, and you have overcome the wicked one.

Revelation 12:11: And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.
